Dear Parents and Carers of Year 1,

Visit to St John's House, Warwick

On **Wednesday 24th June**, we would like Year 1 to visit St John's House, Warwick as part of our History topic on school days. We will visit the school room together and then take part in laundry and upstairs-downstairs activities.

In conforming with the Governors' Policy on Charges for School Activities we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £21.50 per child (£10.75 per child in receipt of Pupil Premium*). We hope you will be able to make a donation although no child will be excluded if he/she is unable to make a contribution.

However, the school reserves the right to cancel the activity if money is insufficient to cover costs. Please make payment by Wednesday 3rd June via School Money.

The coach will leave school at 9.30am and will return by the end of school. The children must:

- wear school uniform and shoes
- bring a raincoat and/or a sun hat (dependent on the weather)
- apply 8-hour sun cream before coming to school if the forecast is for sunny weather

The children will need to bring a **packed lunch** with a drink and a separate drink of water for break time and put in a small backpack, which your child will carry with them. A separate fruit snack would also be welcome for during the morning.
