Funding Structure and Session Structure

This document outlines the funded hours we offer, the structure of our sessions, and the additional paid options available to families. It is designed to align with Warwickshire County Council's expectations for clarity, transparency, and compliance with Early Education Funding (EEF) requirements.

We are open 8am till 4pm, Monday to Friday Term-Time only.

Funded Hours Offered

Bishops Tachbrook Pre-School offers 25 hours of Early Education Funding per week. This is the maximum number of funded hours we accept. We do not offer the 30-hour entitlement.

Funded Session Pattern (**Fully Funded Place**)

To access a fully funded place, children must attend:

Monday to Friday - 8:30am - 1:30pm

Total: 25 funded hours per week

This session pattern ensures families can access a fully funded place without any additional charges, provided they attend the full 25-hour pattern.

Parents would also need to provide their child with their own snack and lunch for a fully funded place.

This must be in line with the NHS Healthy Eating Guidance



Session Structure

Morning + Lunchtime Session (Funded)

8:30am - 1:30pm

Covered entirely by Early Education Funding (up to 25 hours per week)

Parents must provide a morning snack

Morning + Lunchtime Session (None-Funded)

8:30am - 1:30pm

Charged at £8.50 per hour = £42.50

Parents must provide a morning snack

Lunch options:

Hot school dinner: £2.65 (subject to school price changes)

Packed lunch from home

Optional Afternoon Session (Paid)

Families may choose to extend their child's day beyond the funded hours.

1:30pm - 3:30pm (2 hours)

Charged at £8.50 per hour

Total cost per afternoon session: **£17.00**

Children must attend the full 2-hour block if staying for the afternoon

This additional time is not covered by Early Education Funding and is billed directly to parents.

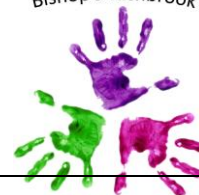
We now offer two add on sessions:

8am-8:30am - £5

3:30-4pm - £5

We are a term time only setting and are closed for School Holidays, Teacher Training Days and Bank Holidays.

This ensures that a fully funded place remains accessible without compulsory additional charges.

Full Day using funding and both Add sessions	Attend Monday-Friday, 8:00am-4:00pm Bring own snack Bring packed lunch or have Hot School Lunch	£17 per day + £10 add on + £2.65 Per Day if Hot Lunch requested (Subject to Change) £29.65 per day
Full Day with both add on sessions - No funding	Attend Monday-Friday, 8:00am-4:00pm Bring own snack Bring packed lunch or have Hot School Lunch	£69.50 per day £2.65 Per Day if Hot Lunch requested (Subject to Change)
Afternoon session	1:30pm-3:30pm	(1:30pm-3:30pm): £17.00 per day



Morning Session	8:30-1:30pm	Charged at £8.50 per hour = £42.50+ £2.65 Per Day if Hot Lunch requested (Subject to Change)
Morning Add on	8am-8:30am	£5
Afternoon Add on	3:30-4pm	£5

Snacks and Meals

We do not provide snacks.

Parents must send a morning snack each day.

For lunch, parents may choose:

A hot school meal (£2.65), or A packed lunch from home.

Compliance with Warwickshire County Council Funding Requirements

No compulsory charges are attached to funded hours.

A fully funded place is available without additional fees.

Any optional extras (meals, extended hours) are clearly separated from funded provision.

Parents are not required to purchase additional hours to access their funded entitlement.
