When is it?

The event will take place after school on Friday 3rd July 2026. In the event of wet weather, there is a contingency date on Friday 10th July.

Where is it?

The event will take place on the school playing field with the colour run itself on the athletics track.

Who can take part?

All BT school pupils from Rabbits to Foxes will be able to participate in their year groups. Unfortunately, this year the event is not open to non-pupils or adults.

What is a Colour Run?

With its origins in the ancient Hindu festival of *Holi* to celebrate the arrival of Spring, the colour run has now become a popular event for many school PTAs. Pupils run round the school track and navigate through various obstacles and activities while brightly coloured powders are thrown over them! It's a fun-filled, rainbow-coloured event that can't fail to bring smiles to all those participating and watching!

What should my child wear?

Each participant will be given a plain white t-shirt and they should wear this with old shorts or trousers, and trainers. Pupils will be allowed to wear this to school for the day.

How do I sign my child up?
