VR Workshop for Year 2, Year 4 and Year 5

Dear Parents and Carers,

On **Tuesday 2nd July**, we will be having a VR workshop for Year 2, Year 4 and Year 5 in which the children will experience a world in Virtual Reality (VR). Each VR workshop will feed into the following topics they are learning about in class:

Year 2 – Wild Animals

Children can get up close with some fascinating, and occasionally terrifying, beasts! Children will go on a hunt with an eagle swooping at a mountain hare, a great tiger hunting an unsuspecting deer, a pit viper stalking a treefrog and a school of predatory tuna attacking a mackerel bait ball. The workshop will also help with learning about classification, camouflage, diet and habitats, teeth and adaptation. Children will be amazed at the action and wonder of the CGI whilst absorbing interesting facts.

Year 4 - Ancient Egyptians

Children can zoom back 5,000 years to the time of the Pharaohs to learn about one of the world's oldest cultures. They can explore pyramids and tombs, decipher hieroglyphics and hieratics, learn about inventions such as toothpaste, see how skilled embalmers mummified their dead so they could journey onto the afterlife and meet the animal-headed gods that formed the basis of religion and culture.

Year 5 - Ancient Greece

Children will explore the origins of the Olympics, learn how the greatest minds are still influencing maths, astronomy and democracy, meet the Hellenes and learn about ongoing wars between Athens and Sparta. Children can discover the inventions that affect our lives today, such as the alphabet and the alarm clock, meet philosophers and scientists, from Hippocrates to Pythagoras and learn about the myths and legends of the Greek gods and heroes.

In conforming with the Governors' Policy on Charges for School Activities we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£5.50** per child (£2.75 per child in receipt of Pupil Premium*). We hope you will be able to make a donation although no child will be excluded if he/she is unable to make a contribution.
