Yesterday a rocket launched from a private site in Northern China. It is unknown whether there was anyone inside. Upon questioning, the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the Russian Federal Space Agency both confirmed it launched but denied they were of its ownership. The media is alive with rumours, but none of them seem to be correct. No spacecraft has left Earth's orbit since the Apollo 17 in 1972.

## RUNAWAY ROCKET GONE ROGUE!

An unknown space craft launched from a private site in Northern China yesterday and the inhabitants are still anonymous. We don't even know if the rocket was manned and NASA and the RFSA denied being involved in any of it.

The last space mission to exit Earth's orbit took place on the 7th December 1972 to 19th December 1972 and it was named Apollo 17. Commander Gene Cernan, pilot Harrison Schmitt and pilot Ronald Evans were launched into space by NASA and their mission lasted 12 days and 13 hours, completing 75 orbits. This mission also broke several records including; the

longest crewed lunar landing mission, the greatest distance from a spacecraft during an extravehicular activity of any type (7.6kl) and the longest duration of lunar surface activities.

The media has been alive with rumours of what has happened and what might happen in the future. Some think that there has been a malfunction in the rocket's system, causing it to take off; others think that astronauts have been sent on a secret mission no-one knows about. A few rumours even mention aliens stealing our rockets. We have interviewed NASA on the occasion they have reported that many Americans have been buzzing with ideas.

Many NASA and RFSA scientists and astronauts have been looking for the rocket in space and many ordinary citizens have joined the search too. They have been looking through their telescopes at night and will contact NASA if they see anything.

Our space companies and governments are debating on whether in the future you will have to own a license to launch rockets to ensure that this sort of thing doesn't happen again.
