Dear Parents and Carers of Reception children,

### Visit to the Cotswold Wildlife Park

On **Wednesday 12th June**, Reception will be visiting the **Cotswold Wildlife Park** to support our Summer topic of "We're Going On a Safari".

The cost of the trip is £20 per child to cover the cost of the coach, entry to the Park plus a train ride. (Children in receipt of Pupil Premium will be funded).\*

In conforming with the Governors' Policy on Charges for School Activities, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £20 per child. We hope you will be able to make a donation although no child will be excluded if he/she is unable to make a contribution. However, the school reserves the right to cancel the activity if money is insufficient to cover costs. Please make payment by Monday 3rd June via School Money.

The coach will leave school at 9am and will return by the end of school. The children must:

- wear school uniform and shoes
- bring a raincoat and a sun hat
- apply sun cream before coming to school if the forecast is for sunny weather

The children will need to bring a **packed lunch** in a disposable bag, with a drink and a separate drink of water for break time and put in a small backpack, which your child will carry with them.

The school kitchen can cater packed lunches for school trips. Packed lunches will be provided in a re-usable lunchbox which needs to be returned to school. Some photos and more details of the available packed lunches are on the school website: <https://bit.ly/44noGbs> (Parents; School Meals).

Any packed lunches need to be ordered via the school office by Monday 10th June.
