VR Workshop for Reception, Year 4 and Year 5

Dear Parents and Carers,

In the morning of **Monday 24th June**, we will be having a VR workshop for Reception, Year 4 and Year 5 in which the children will experience a fantastical world in Virtual Reality (VR). Each VR workshop will feed into the following topics they are learning about in class:

Reception – Minibeasts

Children will visit the garden as never before. They can meet some incredible beetles and insects and view the world from their perspective while absorbing fascinating facts as they are immersed in a 3D exploration of minibeast life. Children can shrink to the viewpoint of a ladybird, enter a hive of busy honeybees and witness a caterpillar undergoing metamorphosis to a beautiful butterfly.

Year 4 - Ancient Egyptians

Children can zoom back 5,000 years to the time of the Pharaohs to learn about one of the world's oldest cultures. They can explore pyramids and tombs, decipher hieroglyphics and hieratics, learn about inventions such as toothpaste, see how skilled embalmers mummified their dead so they could journey onto the afterlife and meet the animal-headed gods that formed the basis of religion and culture.

Year 5 - Ancient Greece

Children will explore the origins of the Olympics, learn how the greatest minds are still influencing maths, astronomy and democracy, meet the Hellenes and learn about ongoing wars between Athens and Sparta. Children can discover the inventions that affect our lives today, such as the alphabet and the alarm clock, meet philosophers and scientists, from Hippocrates to Pythagoras and learn about the myths and legends of the Greek gods and heroes.
