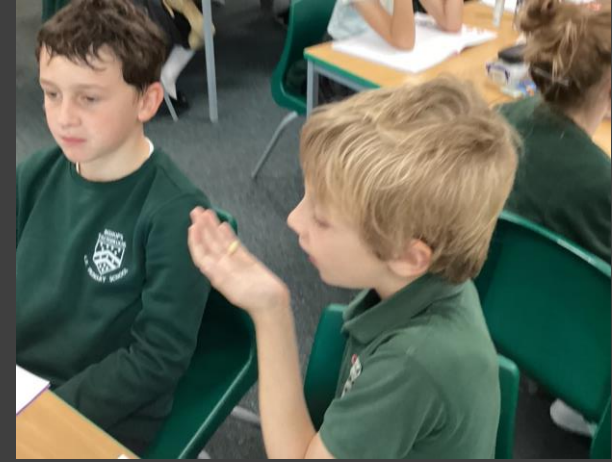
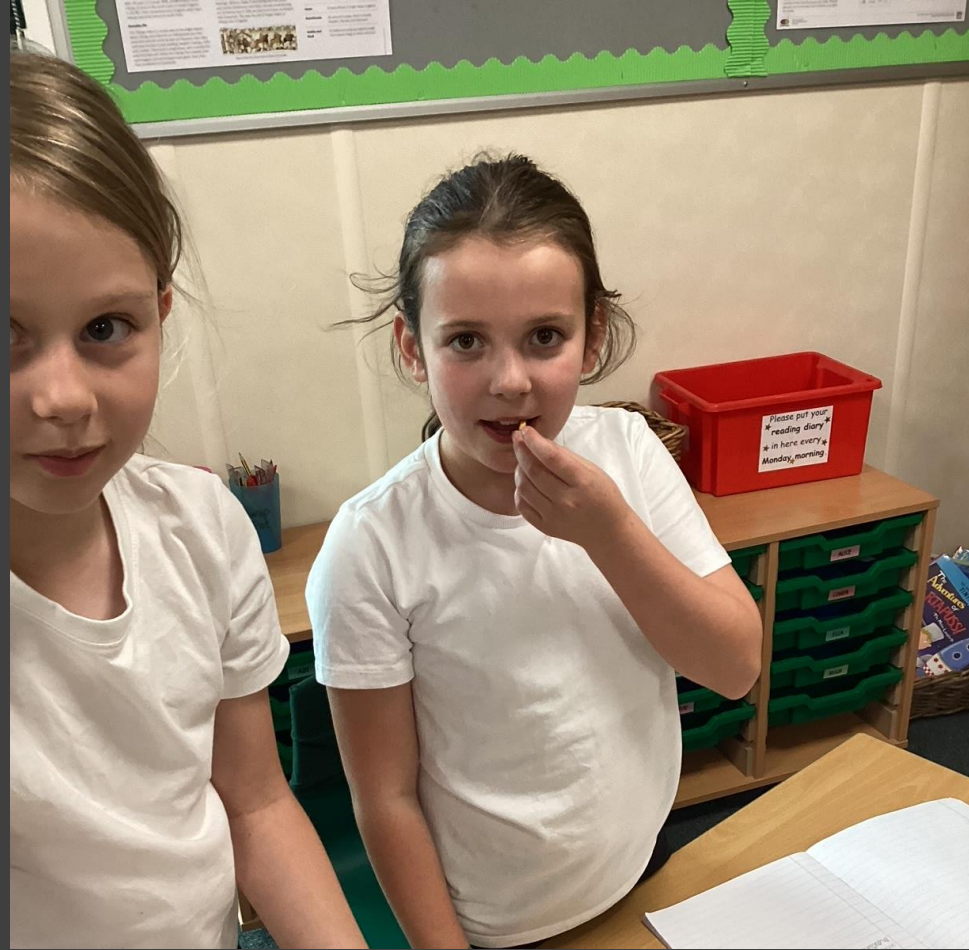
English – after watching ‘Feast’ the children role played relationship building between a man and a dog.

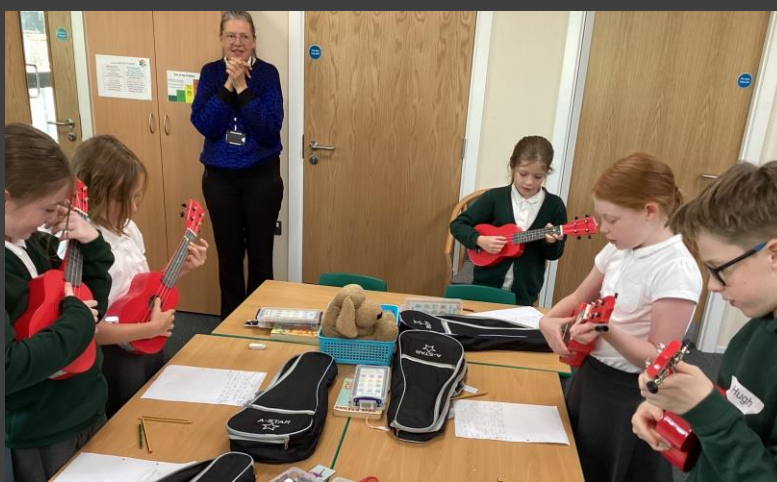

It was great fun making a range of healthy snacks and trying them out to see which were the most delicious...



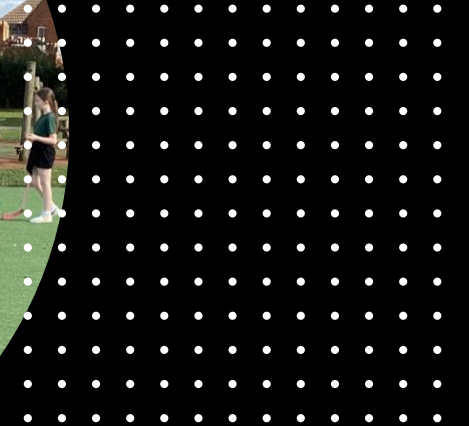
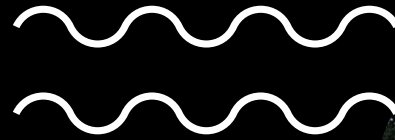


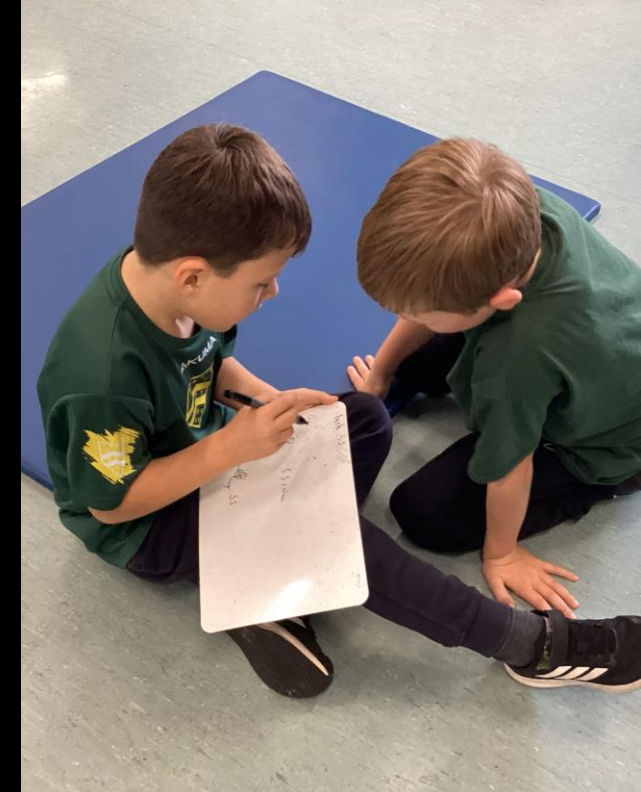
Computing

Onside have been helping us to develop our hockey skills this half term.

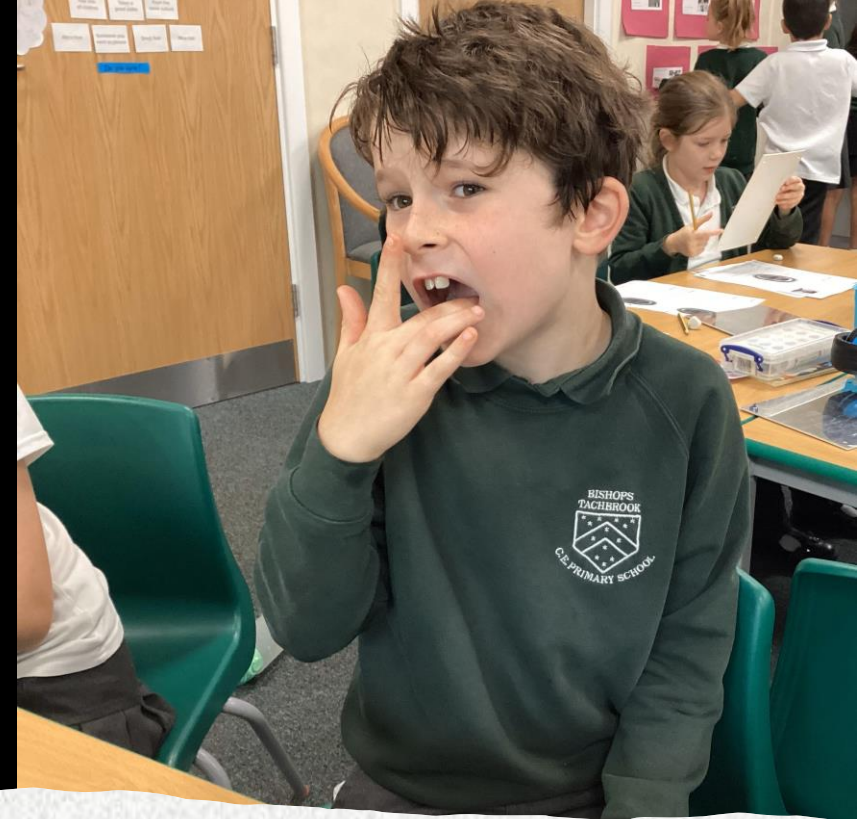




PE - Gymnastics
