History

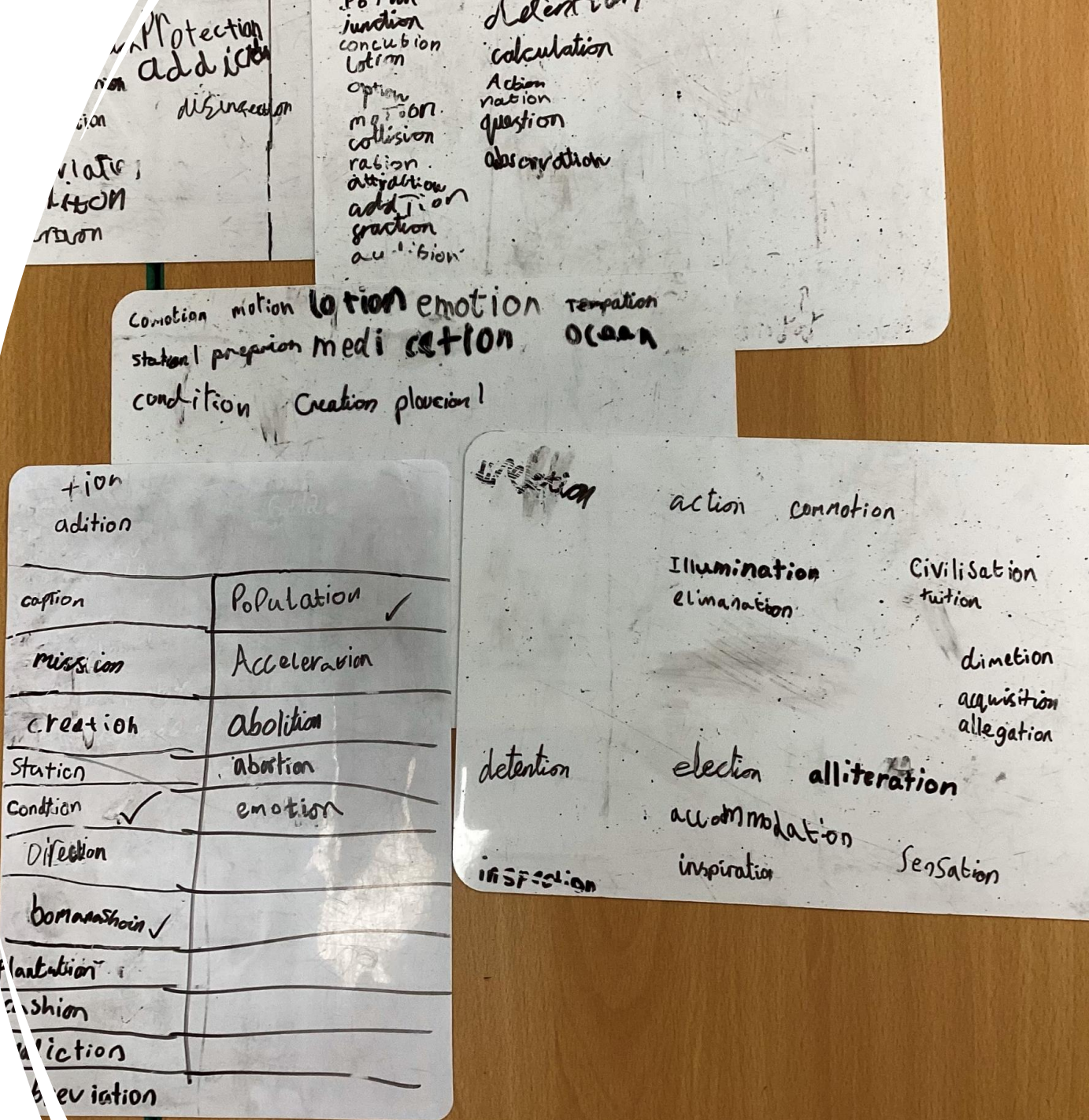
Discovering facts about Anglo-Saxon life.

'_tion'.

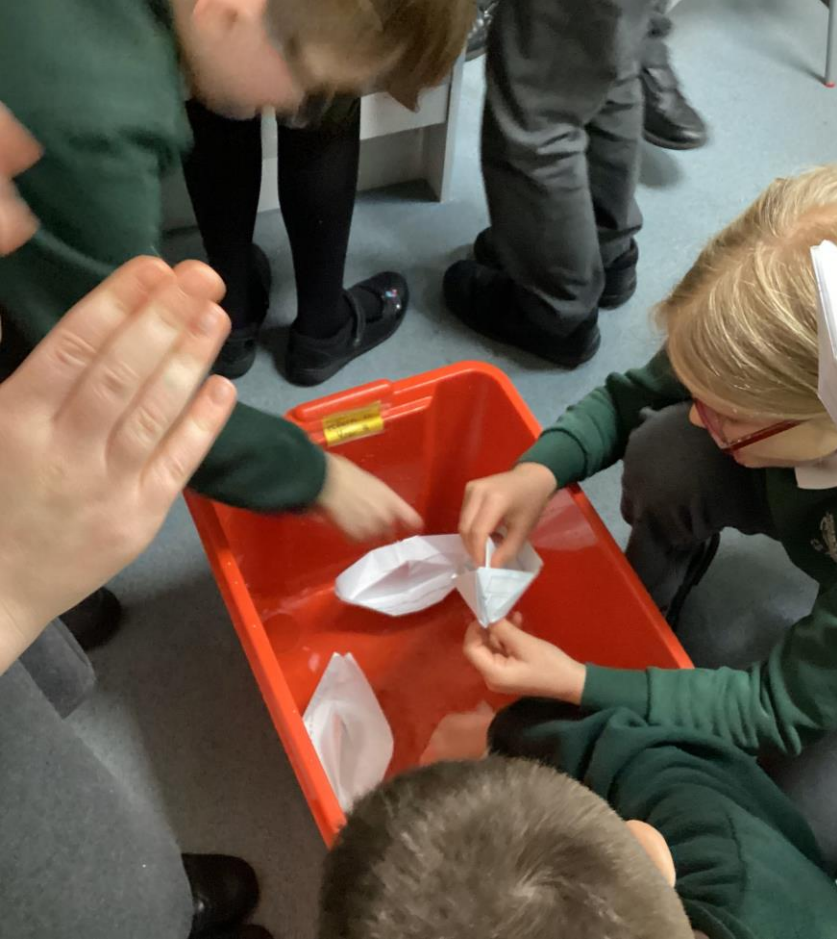

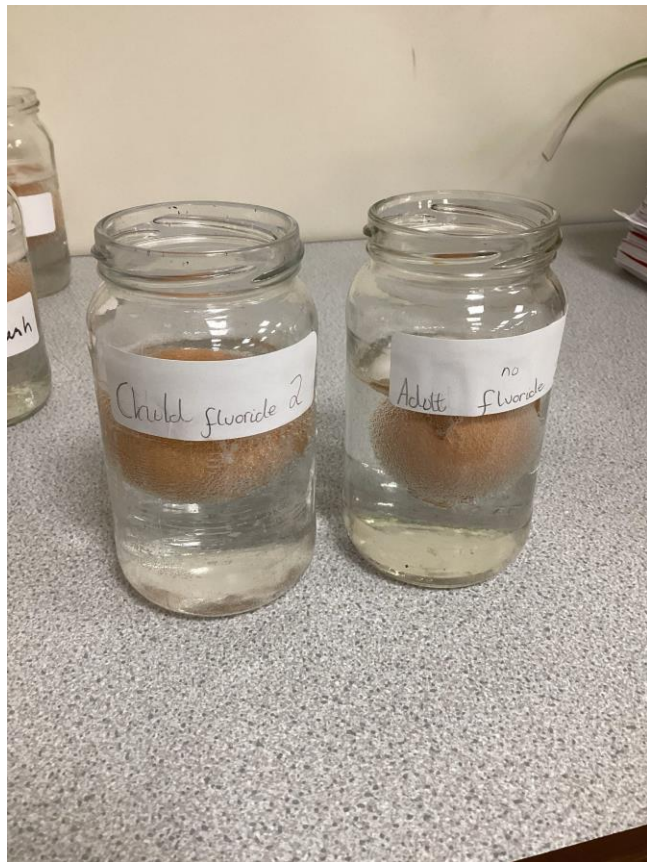
The children were challenged to build a storm-proof shelter. Which would you prefer to stay in if there was a storm brewing?

The children enjoyed working together to create their own snow people.

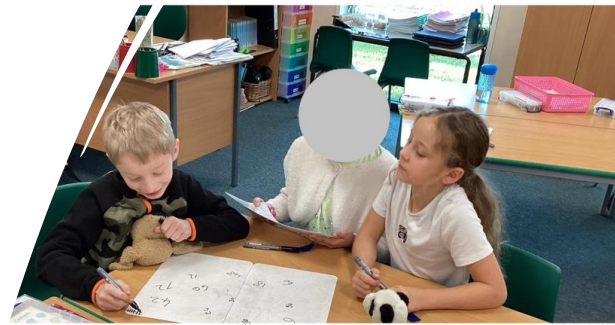

Times Tables

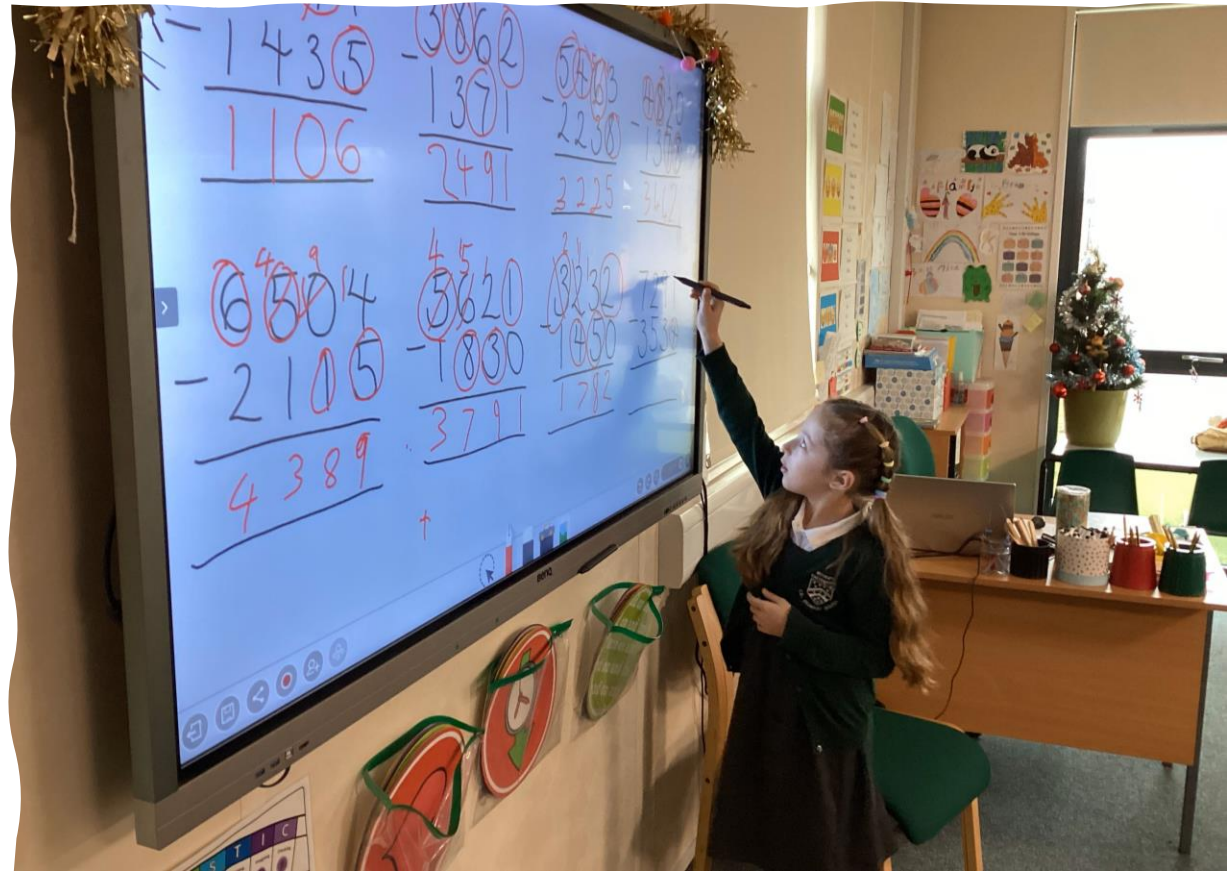
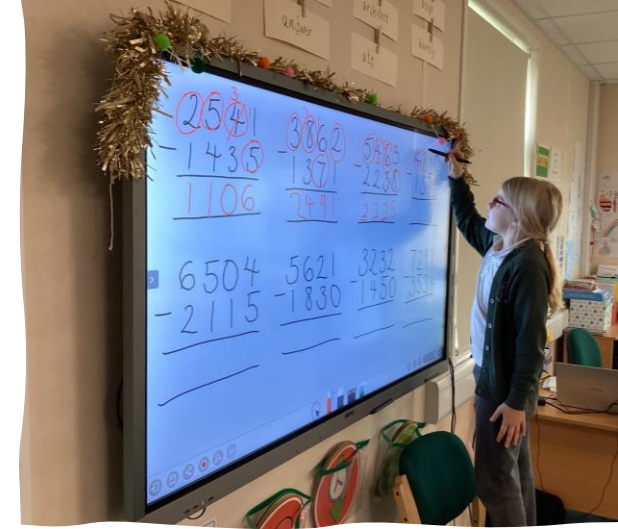
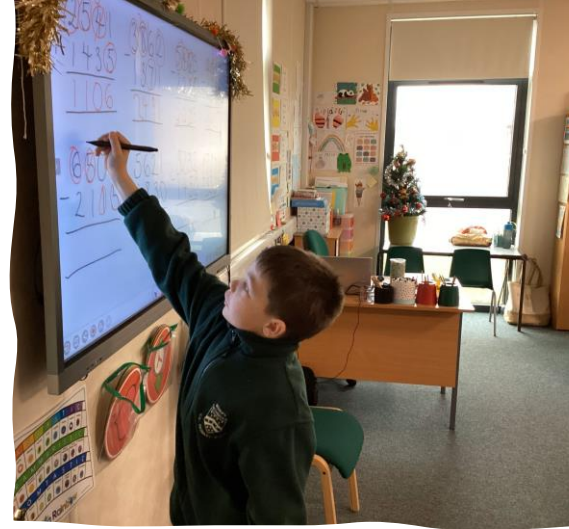
The Year 4 children have been working hard to learn their times tables facts. They recite facts, use the iPads and also play games to practise recalling the facts accurately and quickly.

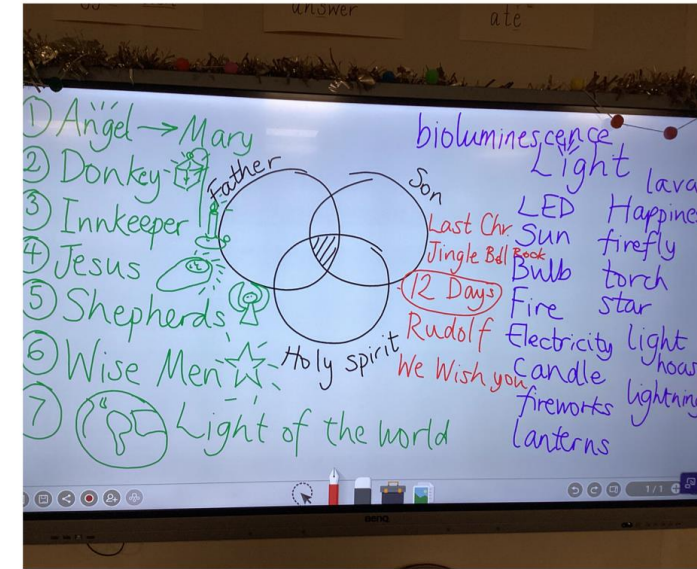


Coventry Cathedral Christingle
