

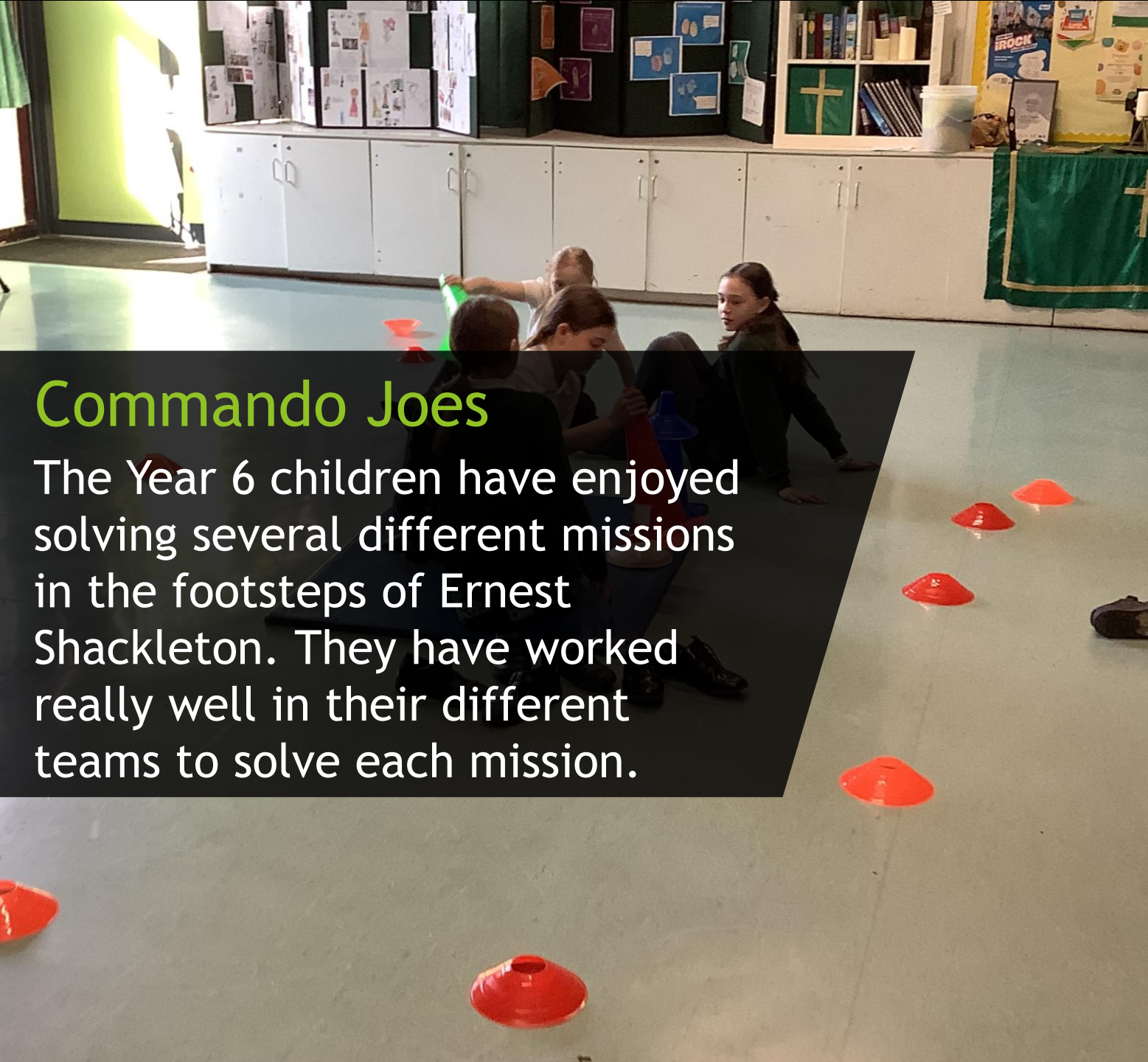

The Year 6 children have enjoyed solving several different missions in the footsteps of Ernest Shackleton. They have worked really well in their different teams to solve each mission.



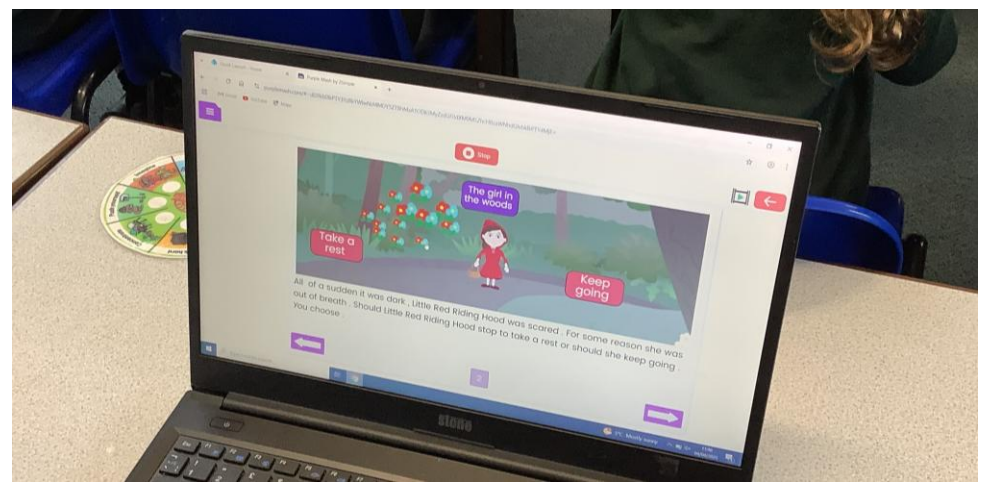
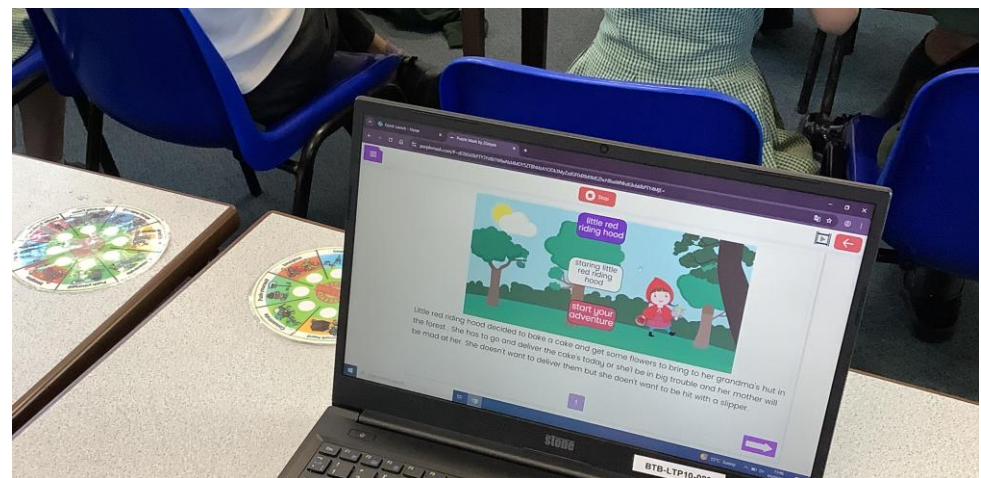


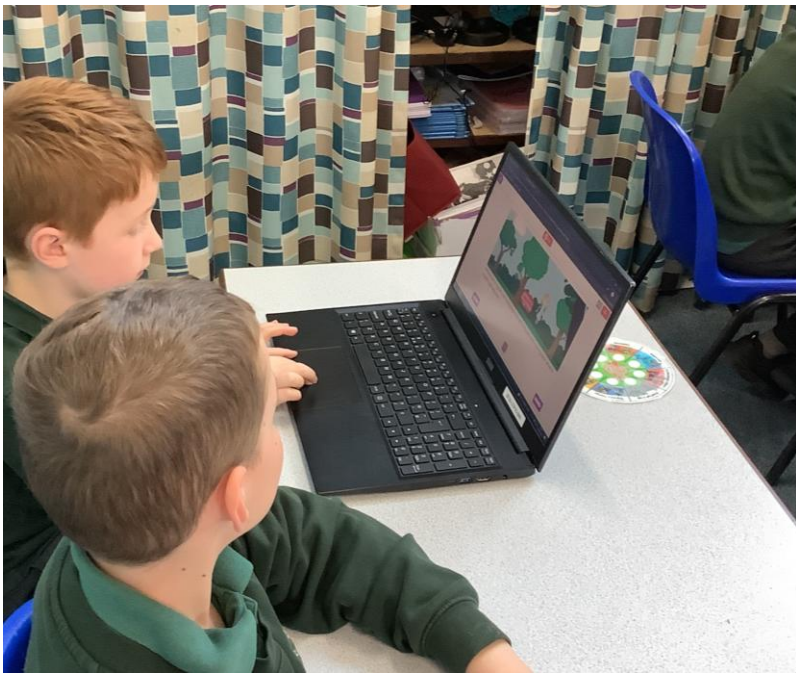


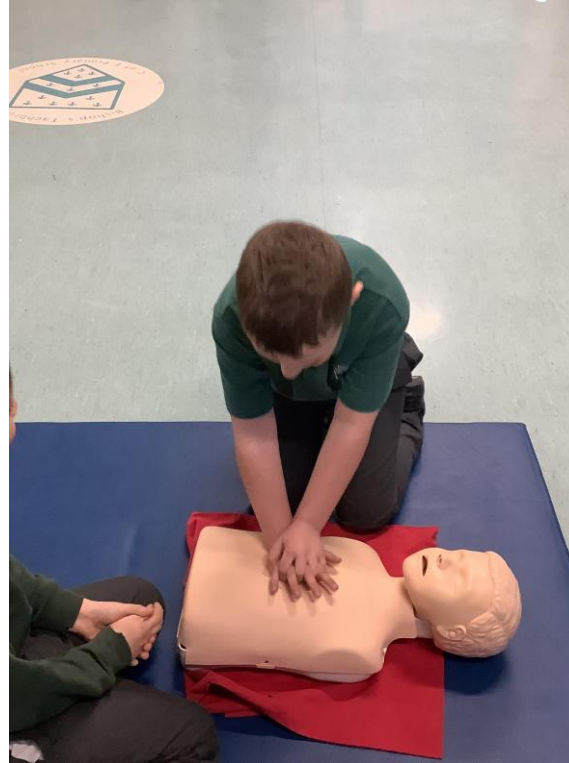
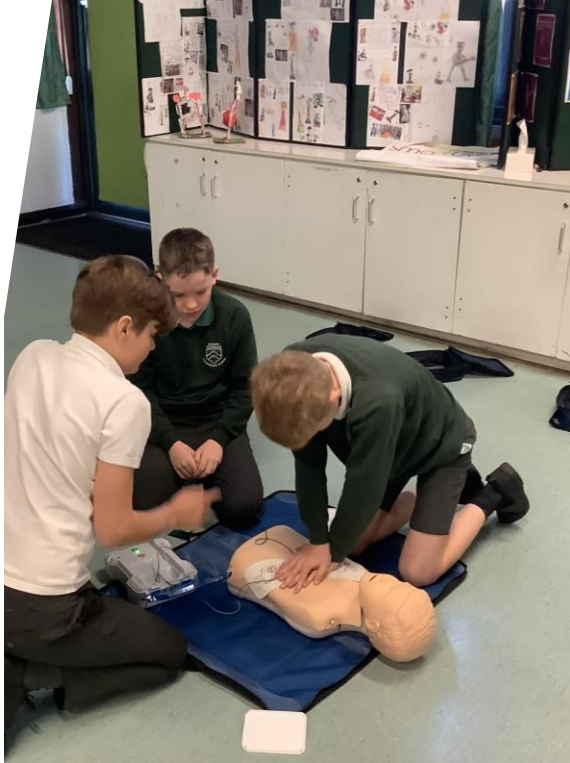
Computing

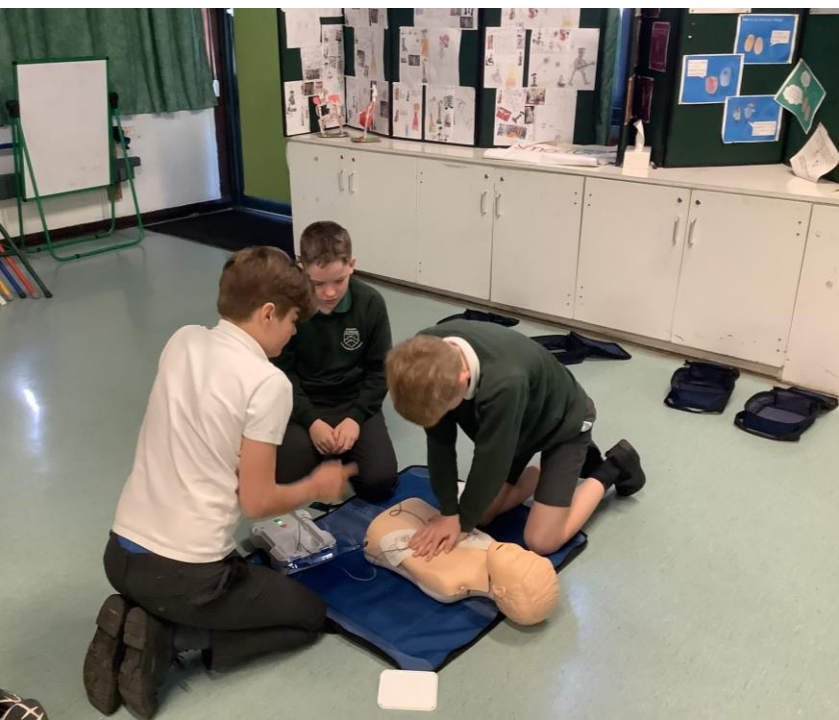


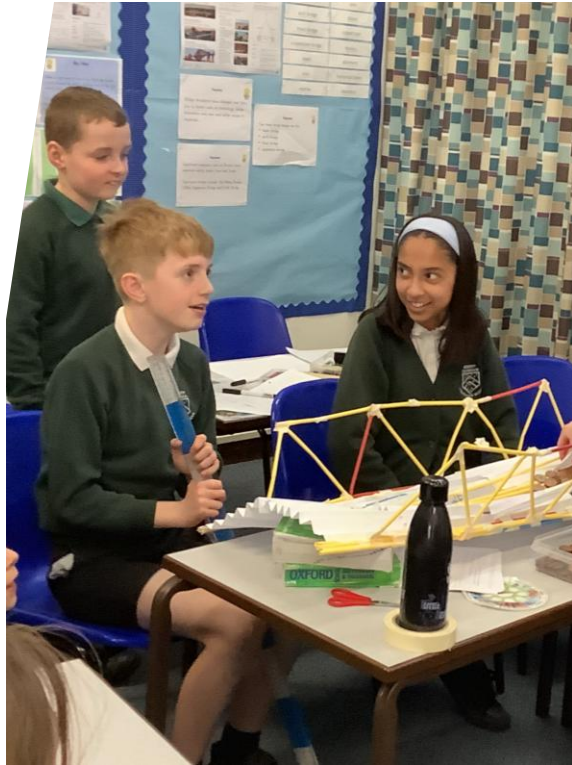




CPR Workshop

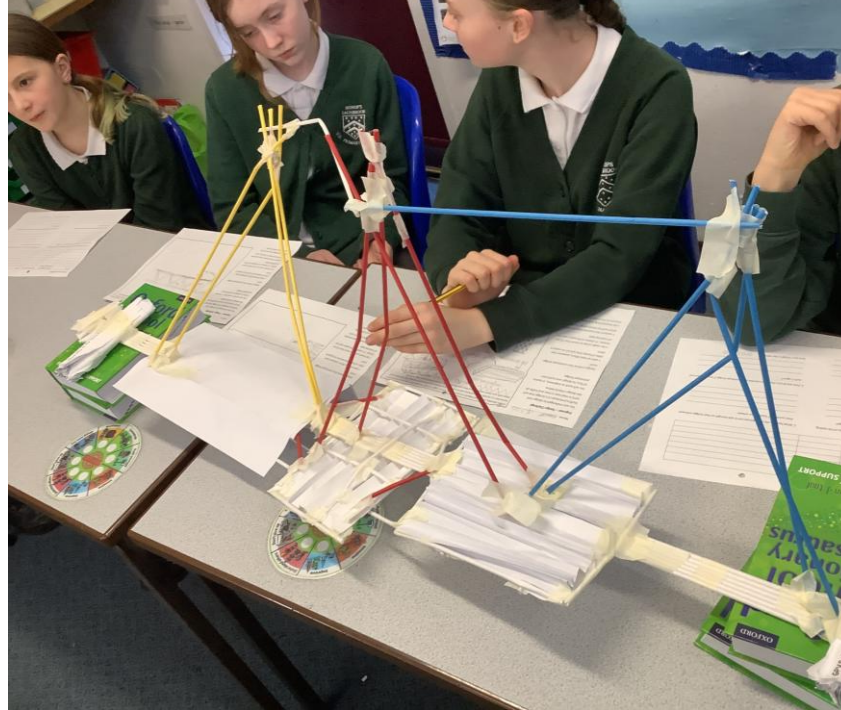

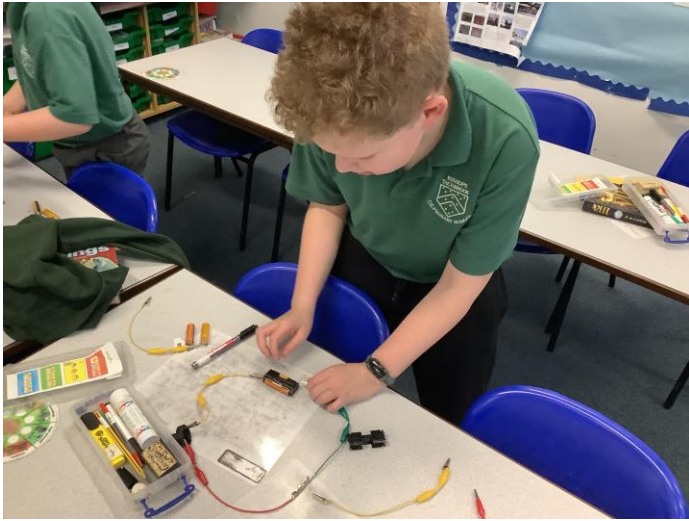




Design Technology
