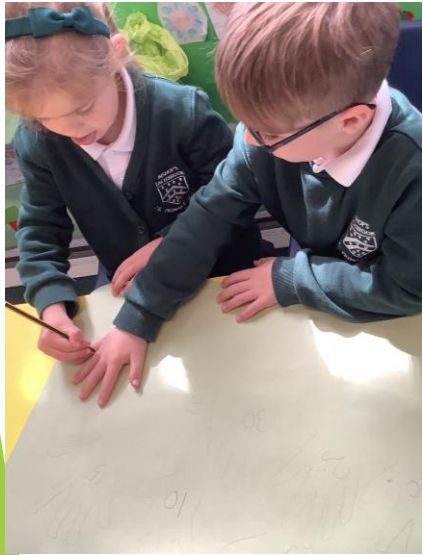
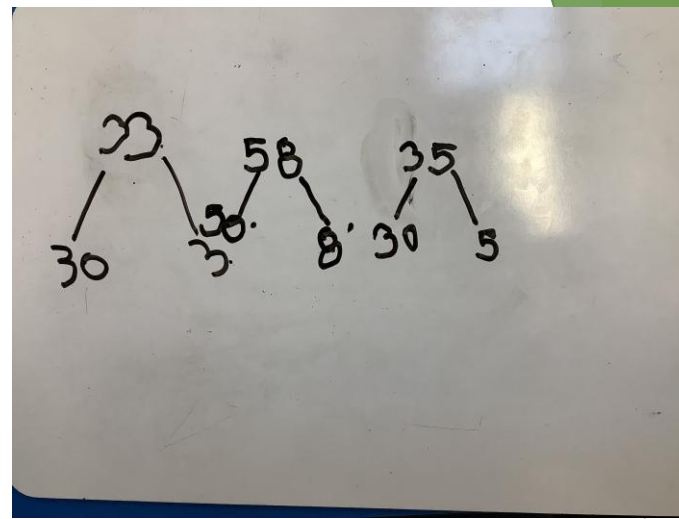
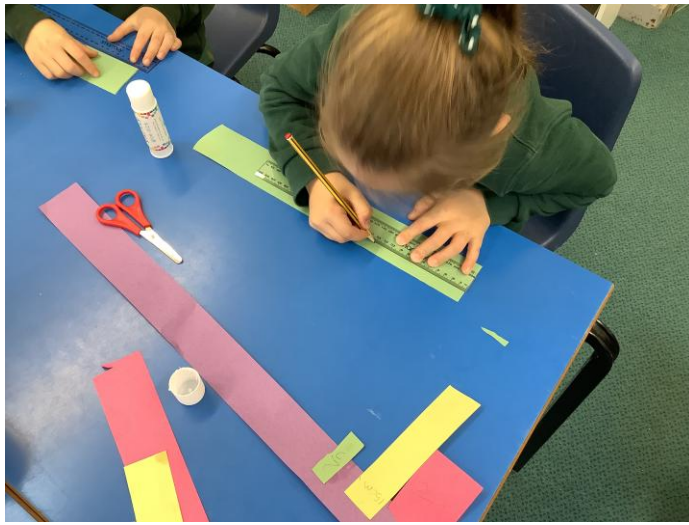


## Whole class story time...

Everybody enjoyed listening to the story about Harry Potter when Lachlan read some of his book to the class.

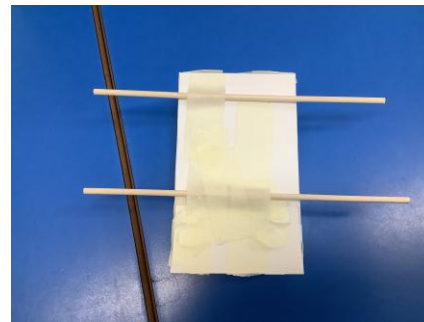
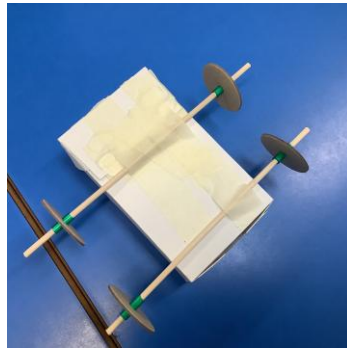


The children enjoyed dressing up for World Book Day!

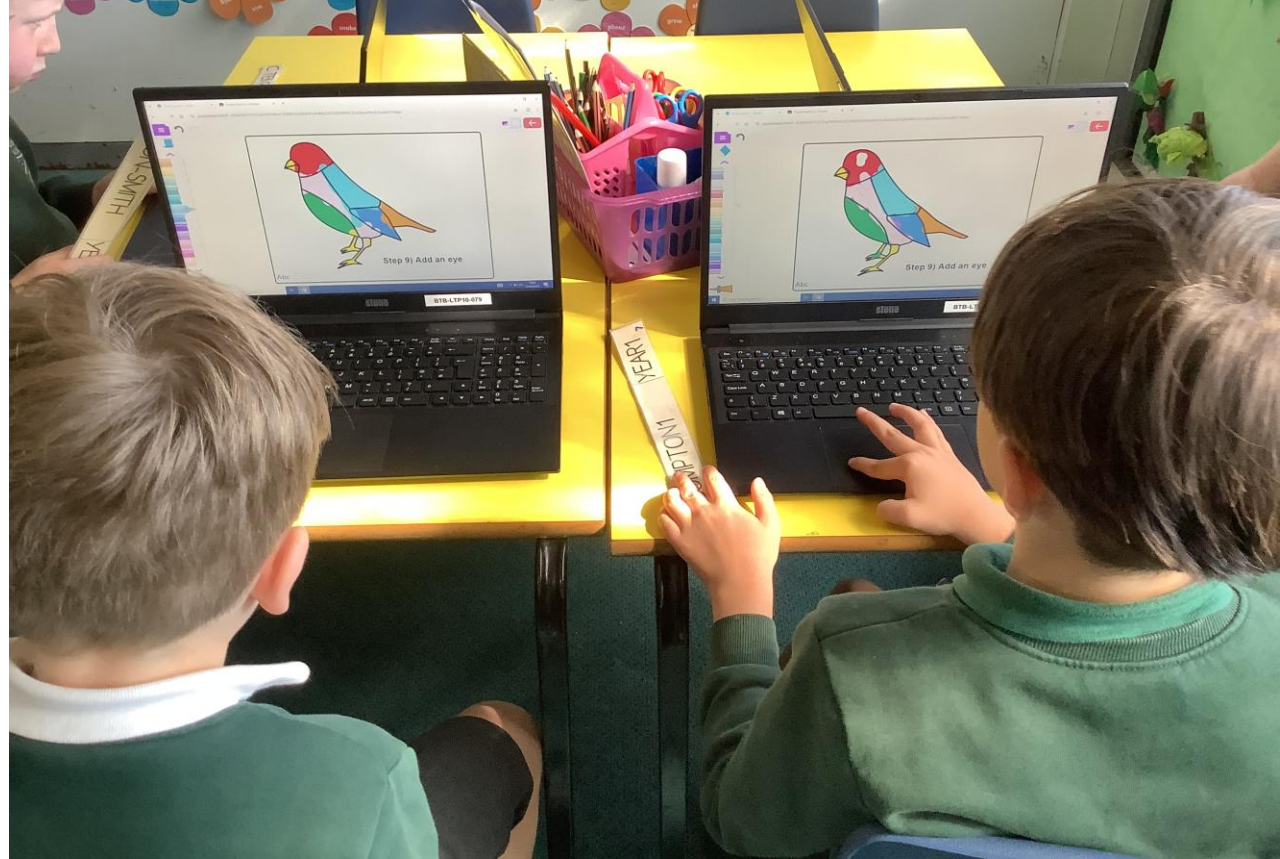
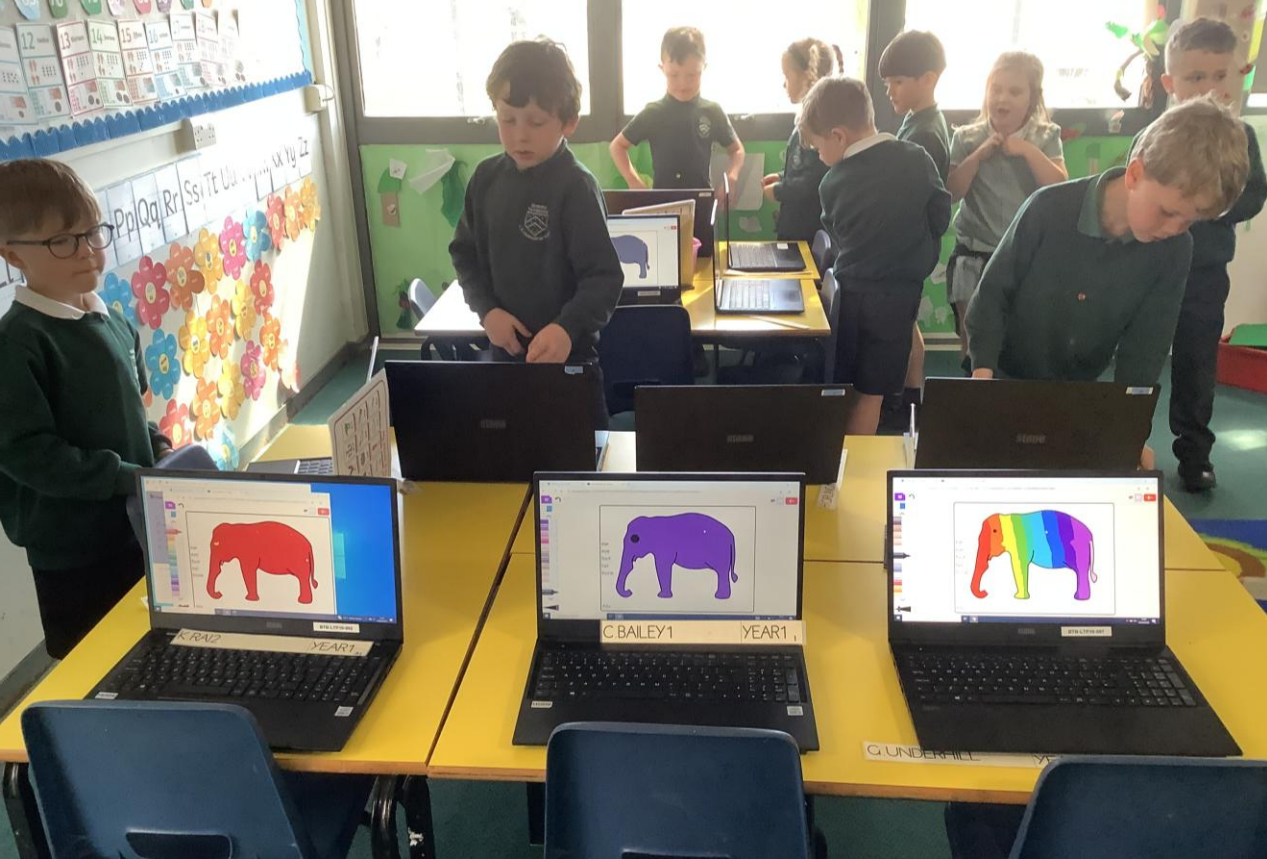
# Designing cars
