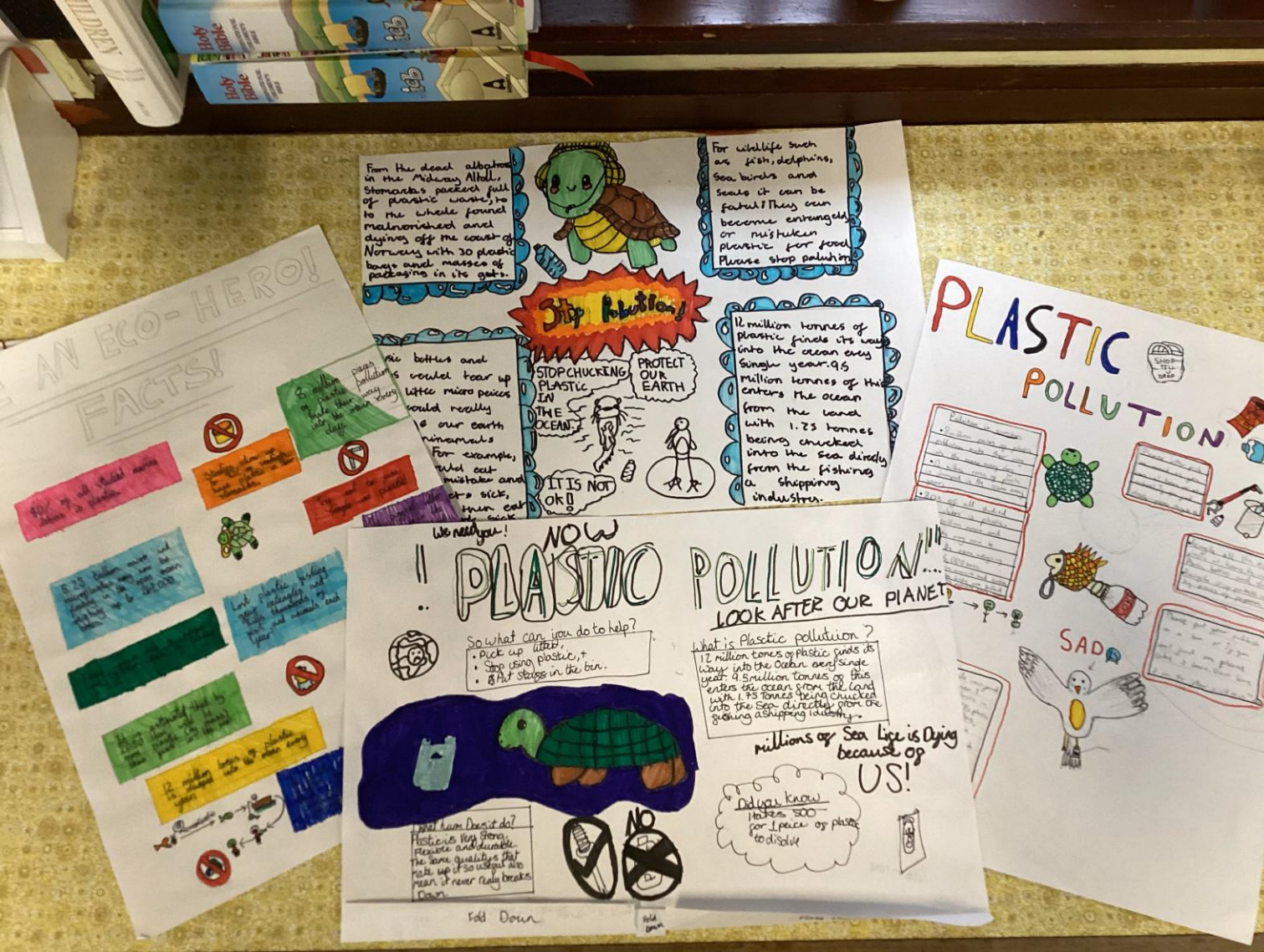


CPR workshop

The children researched the impact of plastic pollution and presented their ideas on posters.

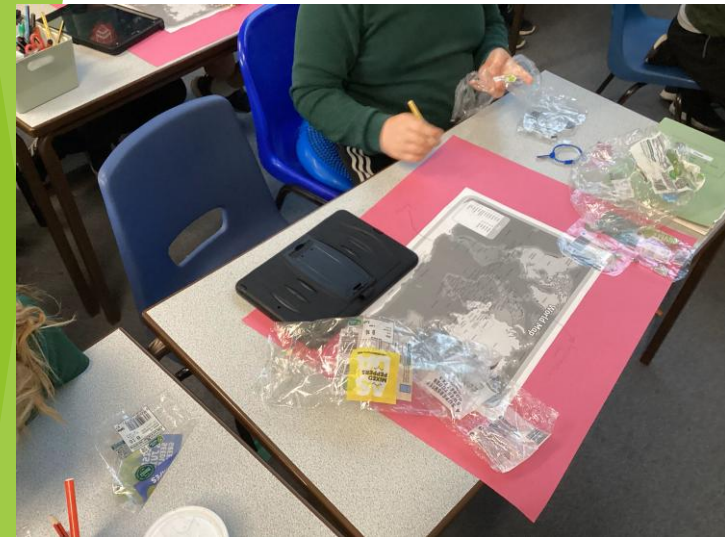

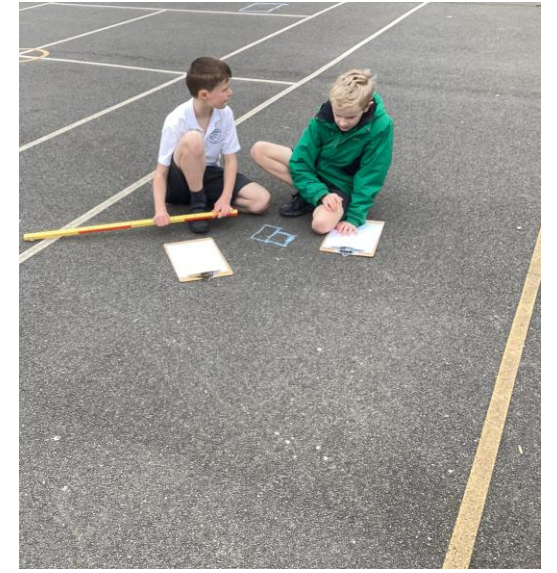
As part of their geography work, the children in Year 5 have been thinking about biomes, and matching definitions to examples of each.

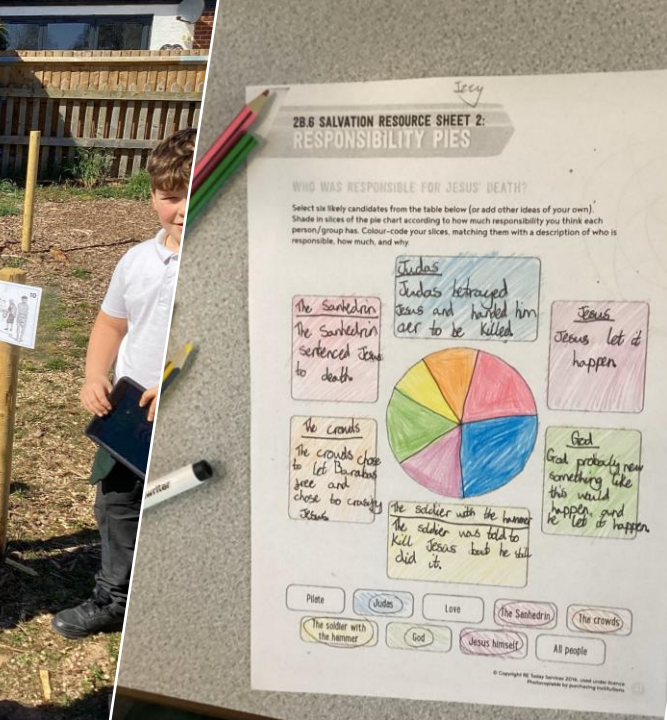


The children collected and looked at packaging of food that had been bought in our supermarkets and shops and worked out how far it had travelled across the world so that we could enjoy it.

The children took their learning outside to help them to understand the concept of perimeter and complete different investigations.

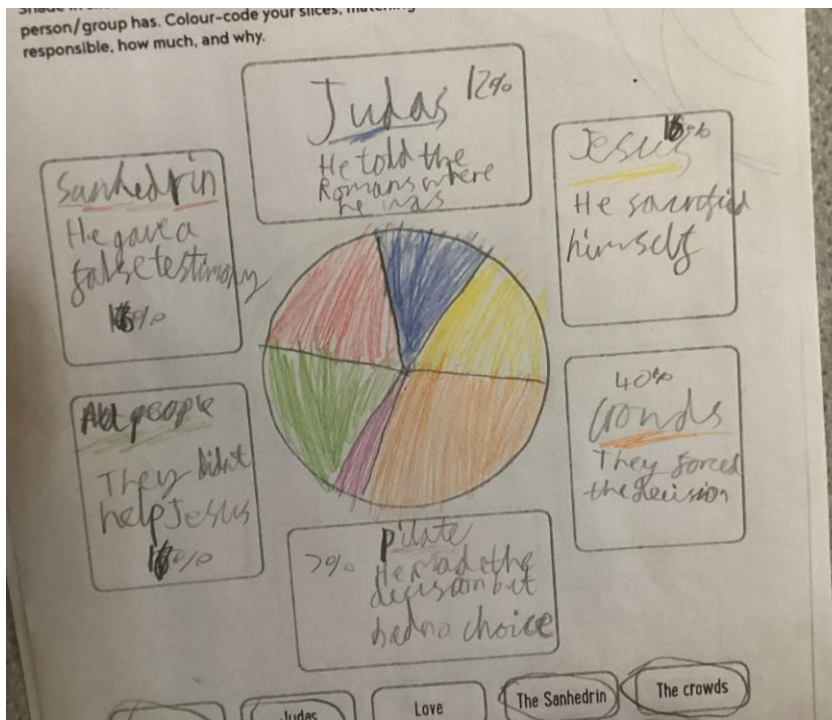
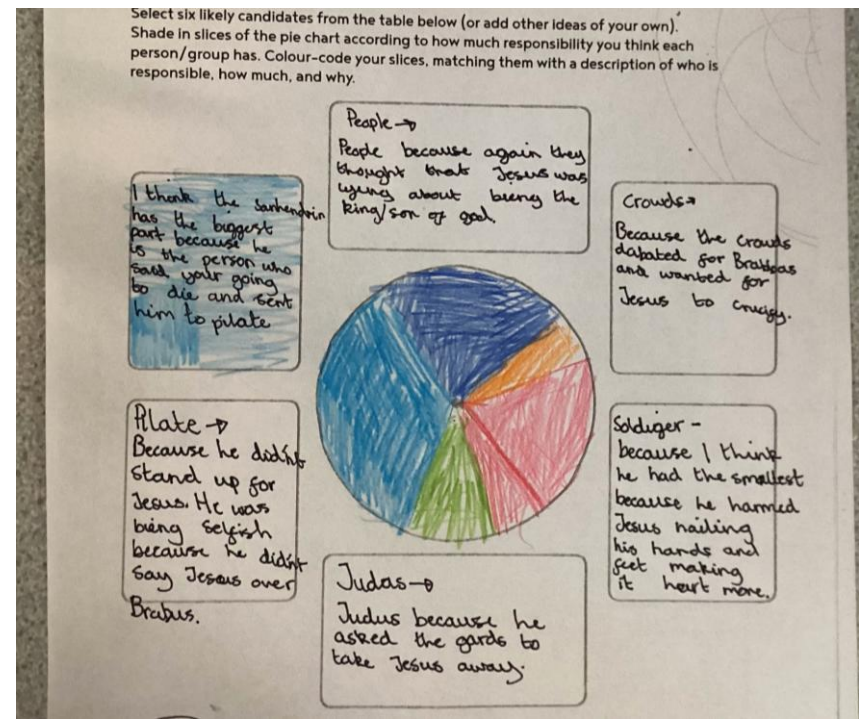
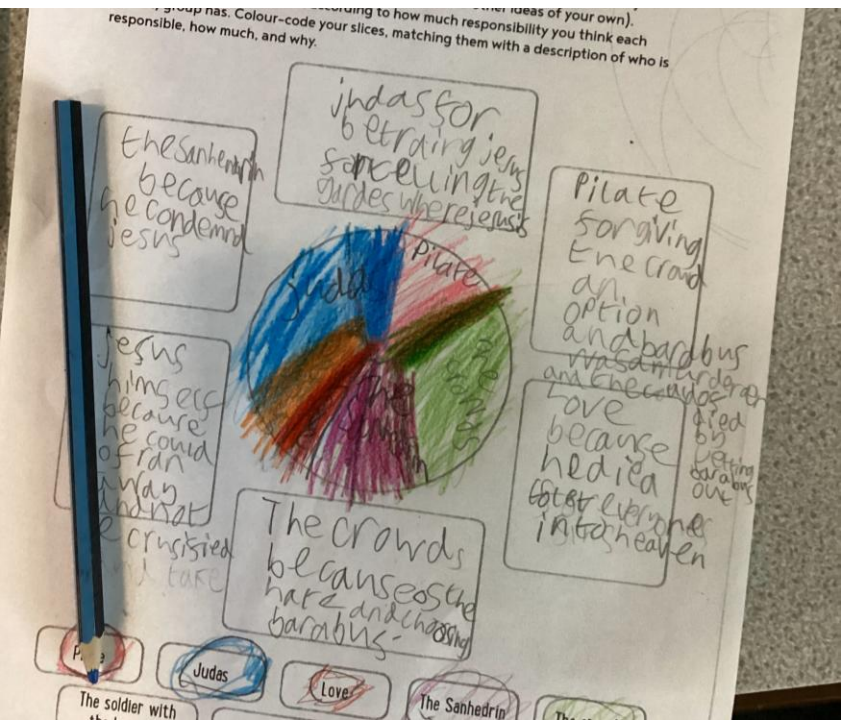
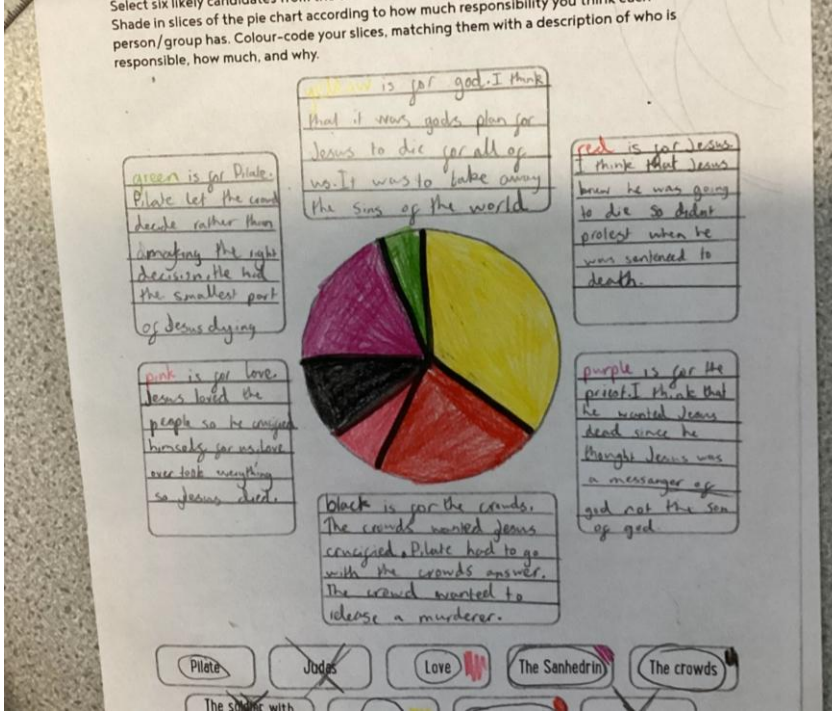
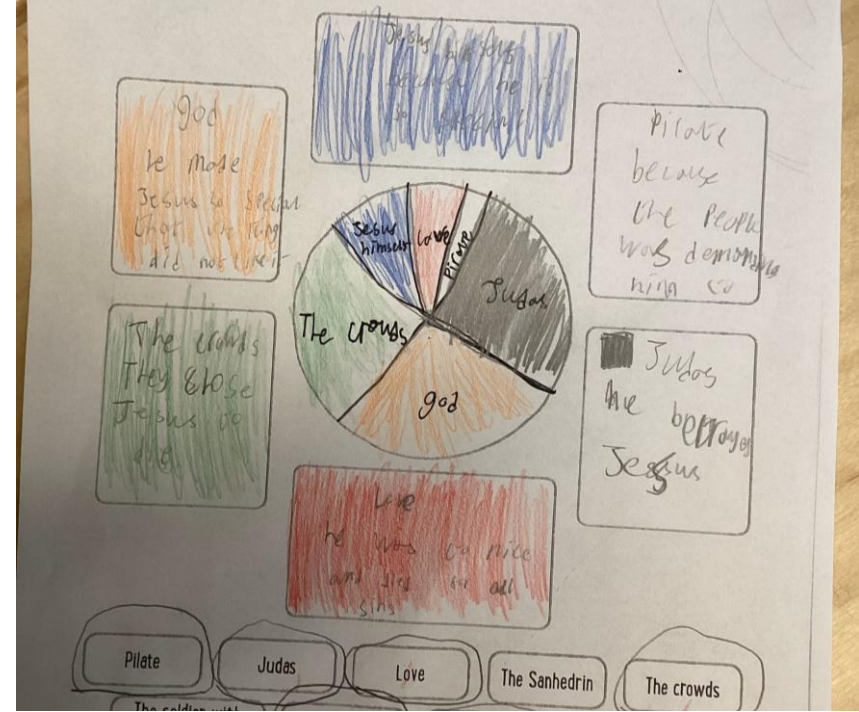
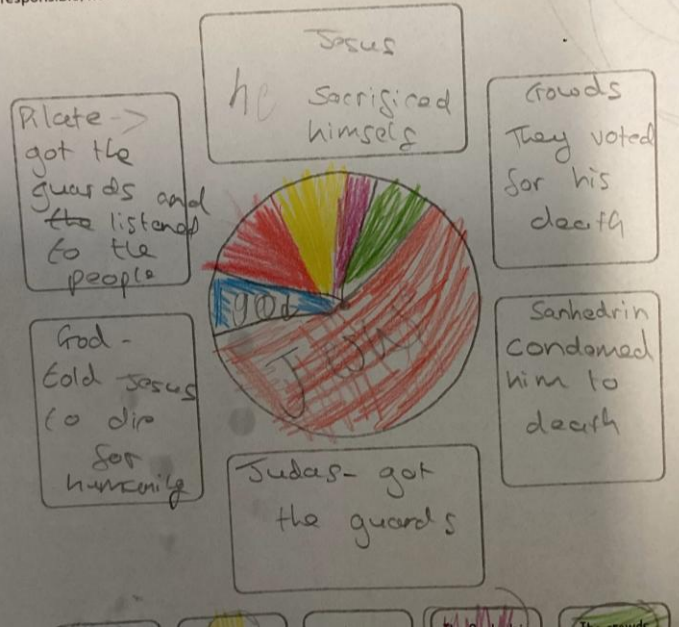


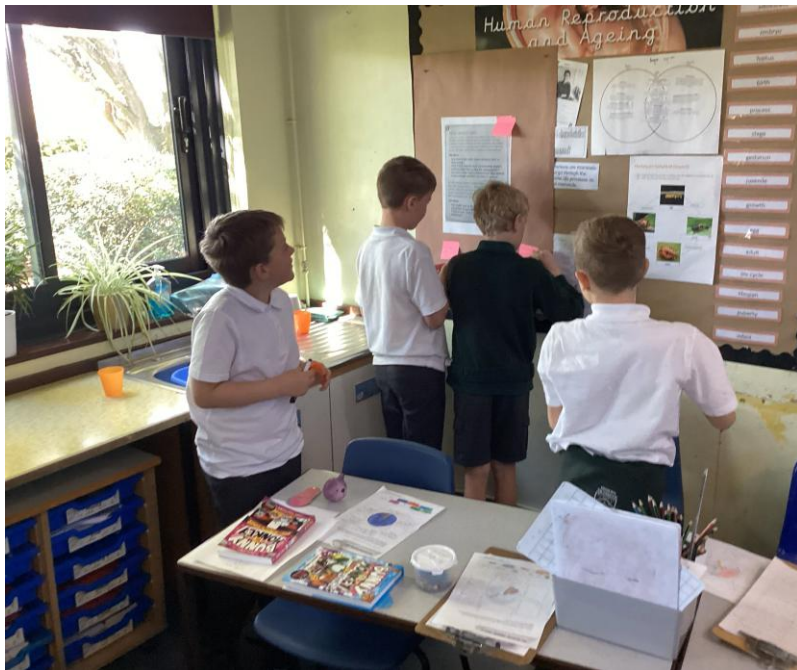
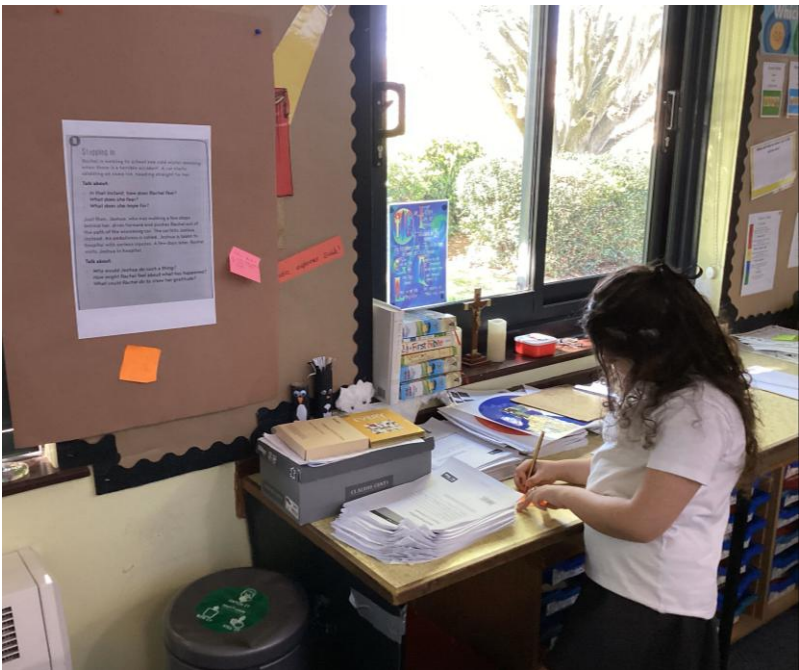
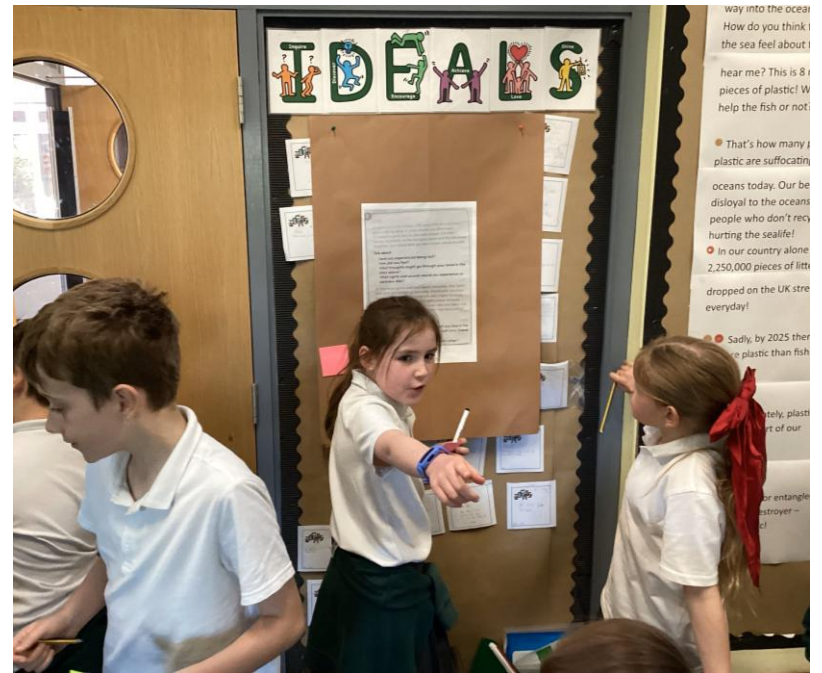
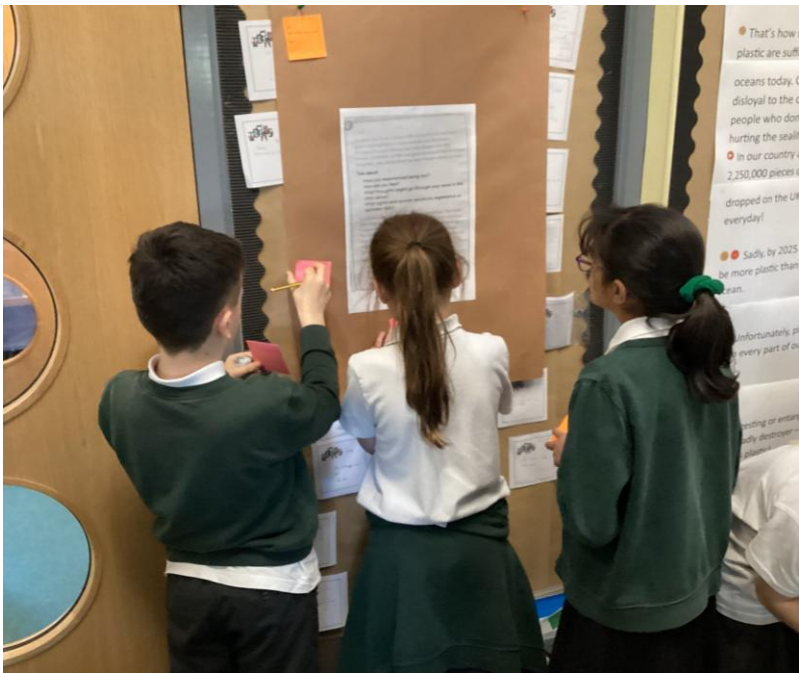
Understanding Christianity Day Salvation
