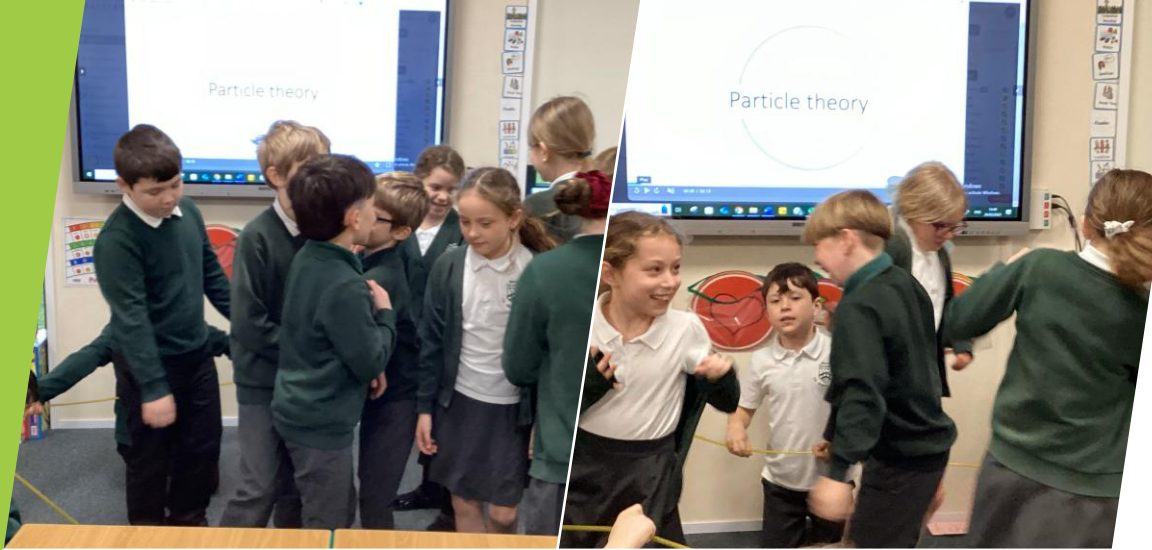

Enjoying a good book in comfort! The children looked fabulous in their costumes. Thank you to all the adults who helped them to sort out what to wear!



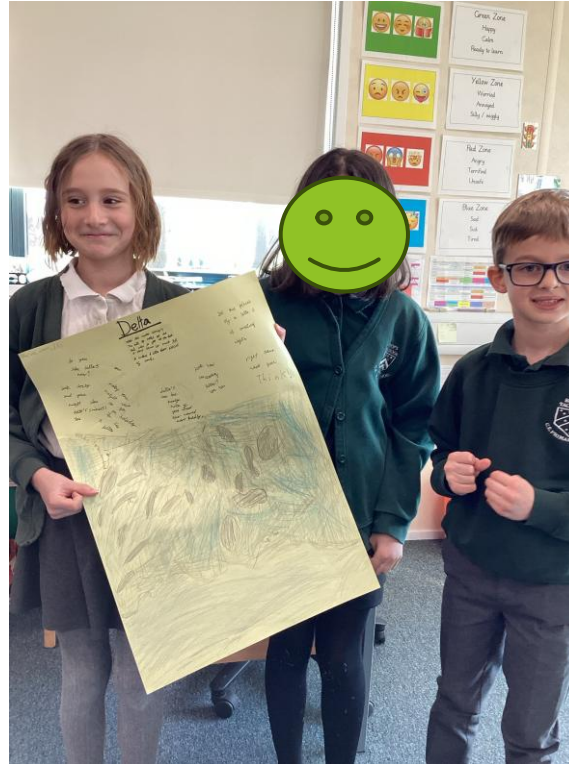
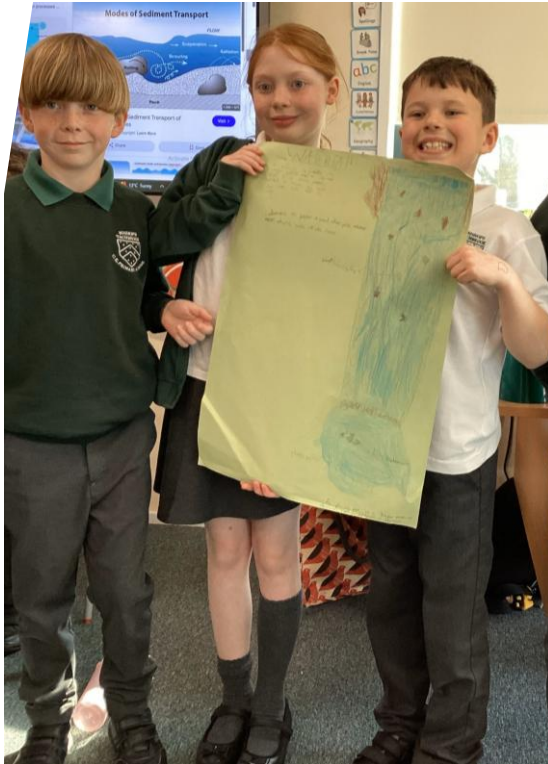
# Commando Joes

# Welcome to Mr Shakles

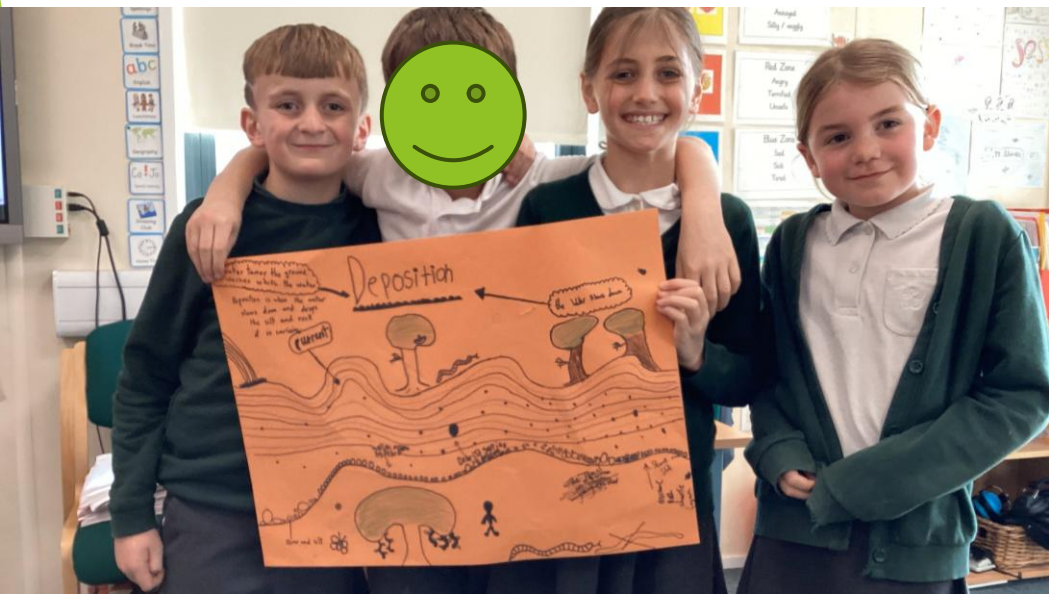
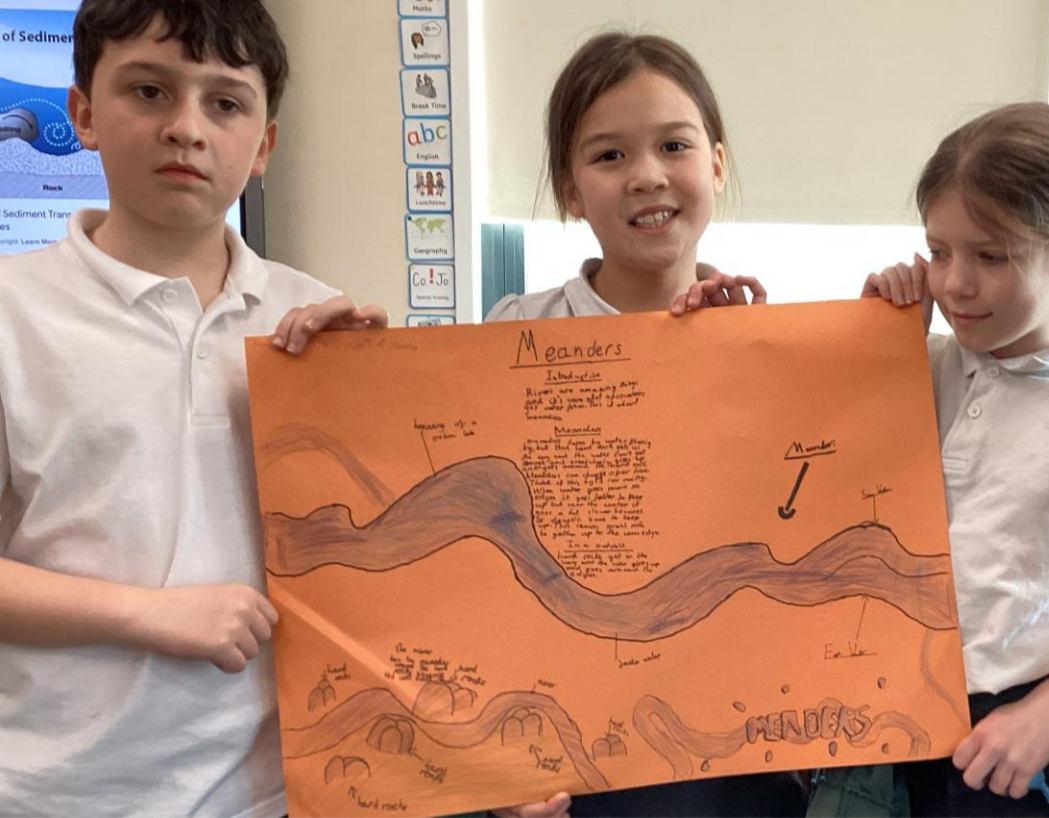
The Year 4 children have welcomed a new teacher to their team this term. Mr Shakles has been working with them as well as Mrs Rhodes.

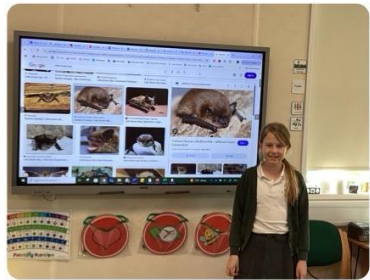


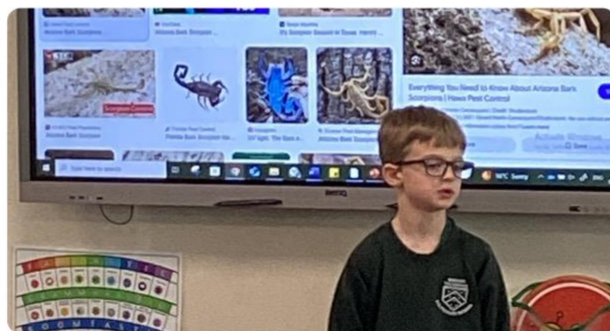
We learned how to do CPR and why it was so important. Everyone took their role really seriously and found the session so interesting!
