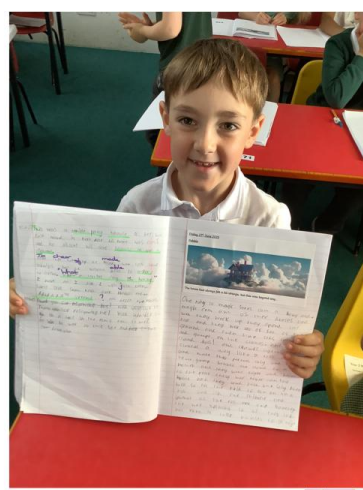


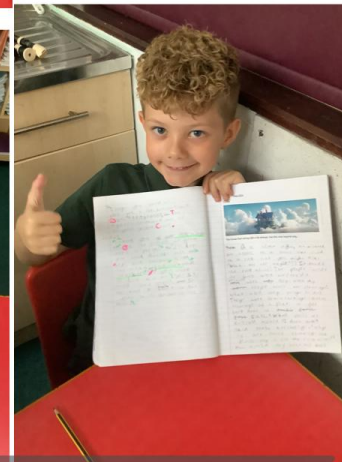
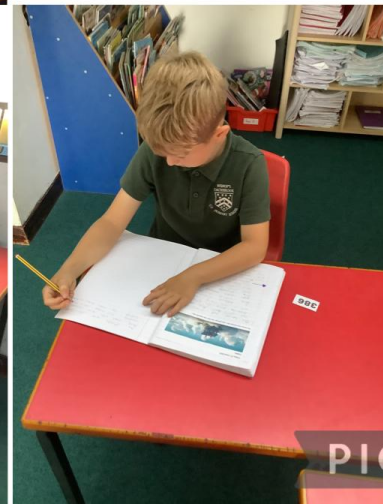
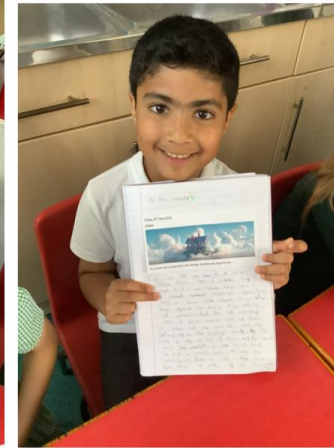
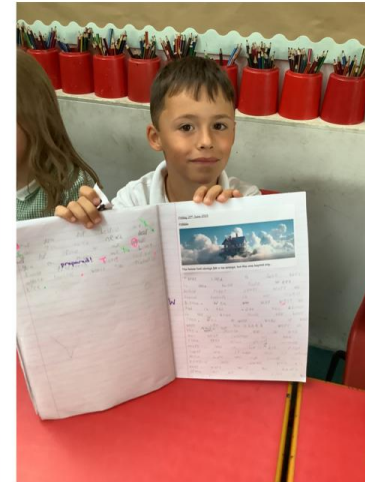
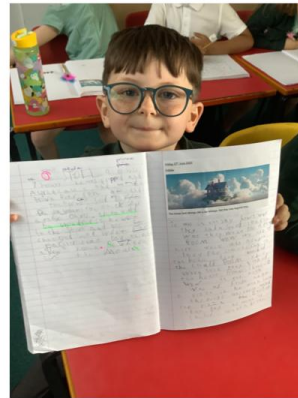
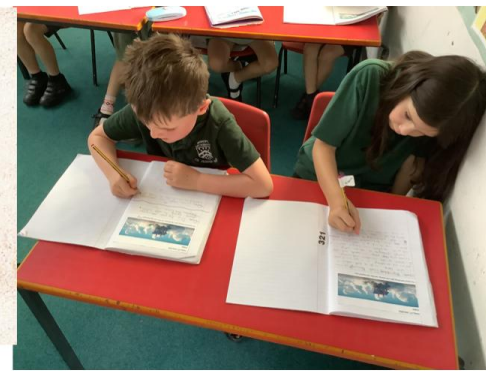


# Year 2

Year 2 on the hunt for microhabitats in Science.

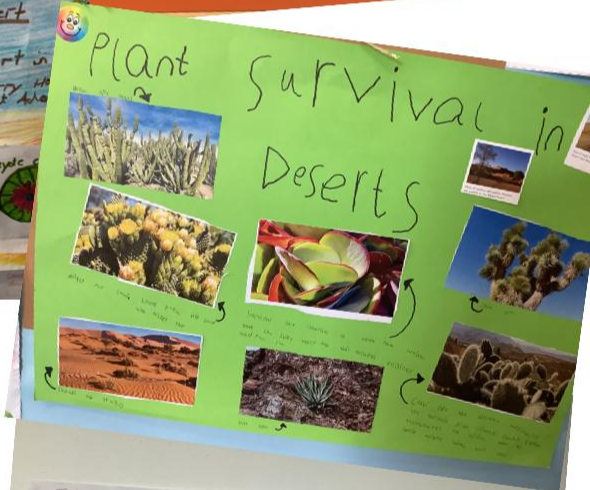
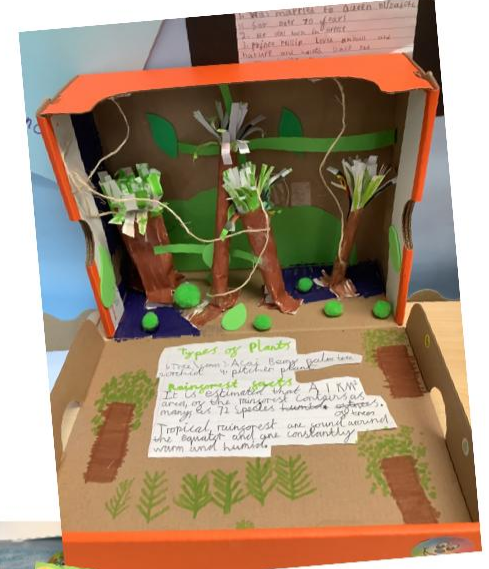
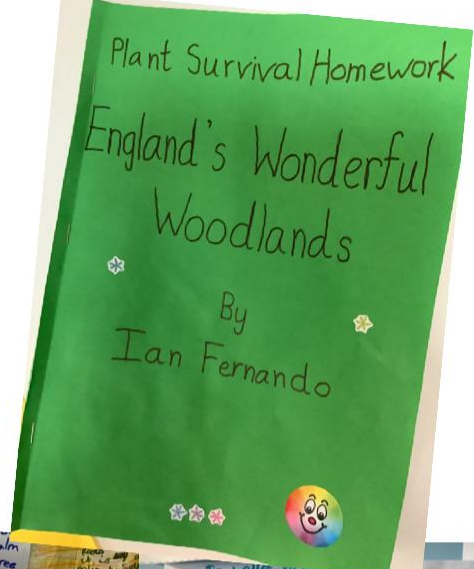
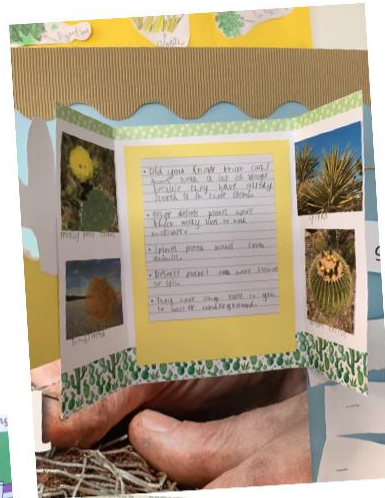

 Year 2 took part in a WWF live lesson linked to their learning about animal survival in Science.

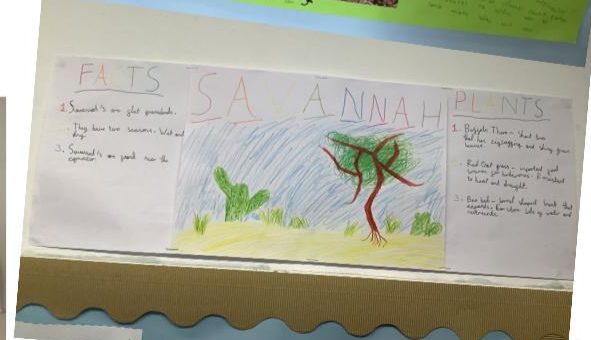


We learned about the rainforest habitat before taking part in a "drawing masterclass" by a professional illustrator.



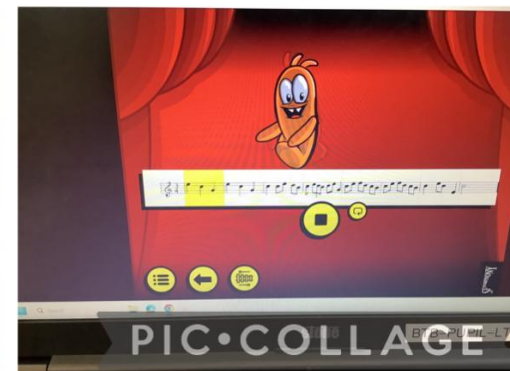
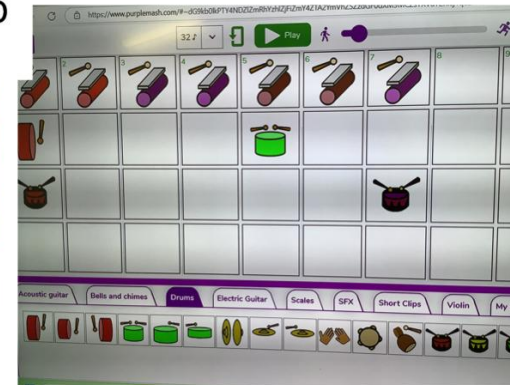


# Amazing Science (Plant Survival) homework projects by Year 2!
