A cave is a hole in the side of a cliff or under the ground. Caves are often caused by erosion or movement of the Earth's crust.

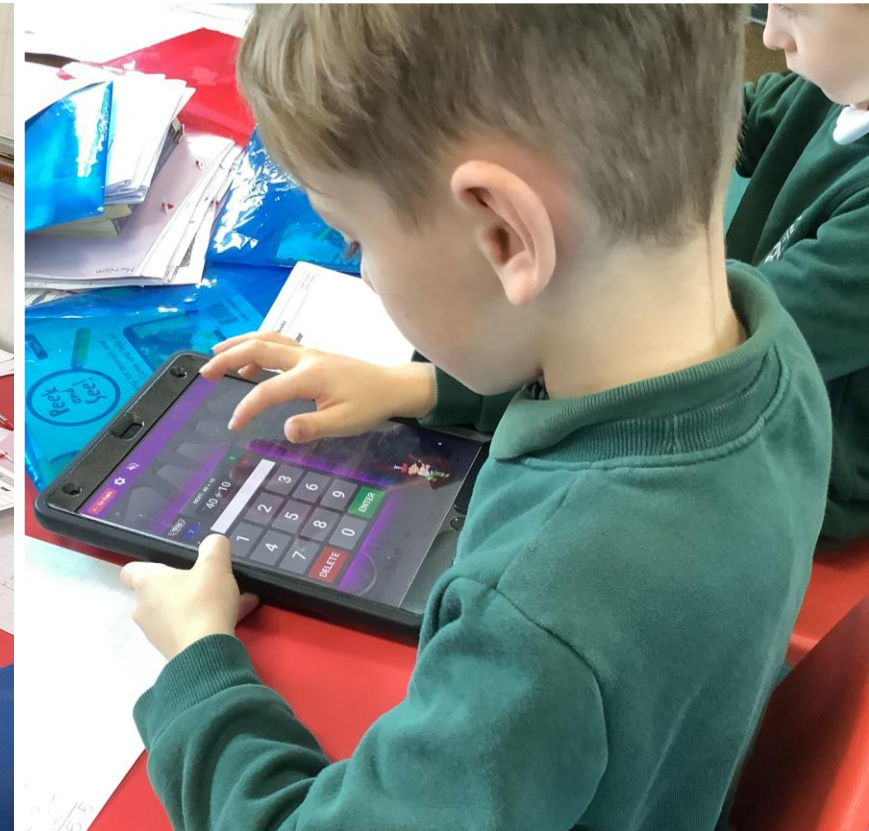
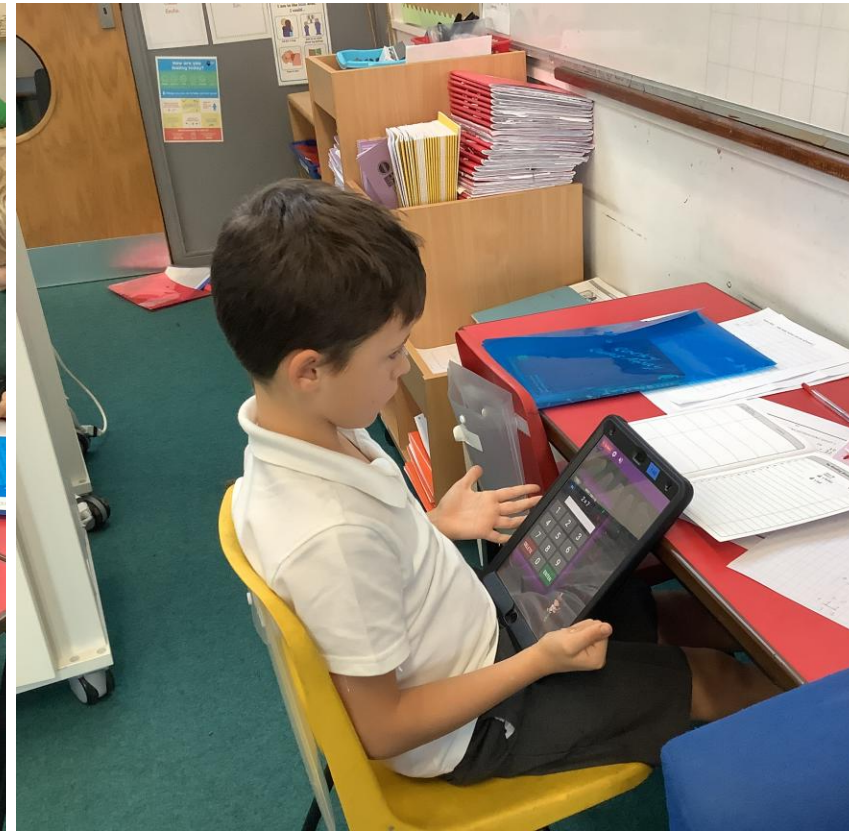
An aqueduct is a bridge that carries a waterway or water supply over a valley. They usually have rounded stone arches.

A cliff is an area of land with a steep side. Cliffs are often found next to the sea.

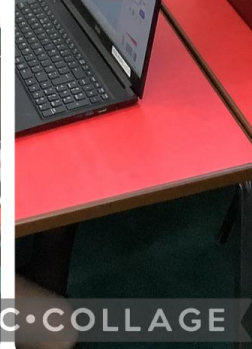
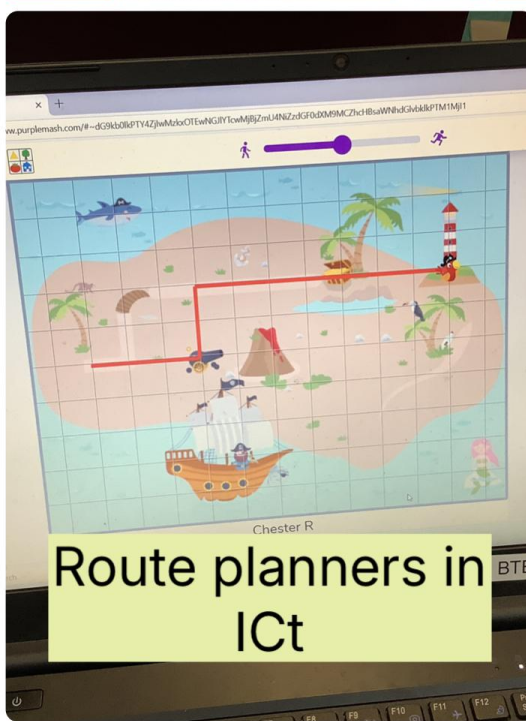
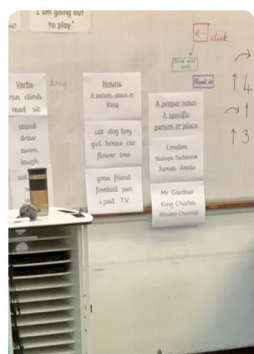
A canyon is a narrow valley that is very deep and long. River canyons are formed by flowing river water over long periods of time.

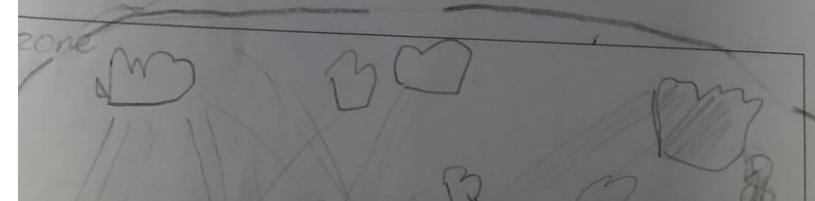
Why might nature and the seasons be an important part of someone's worldview?

Many of us thought that it was really important to look after nature.

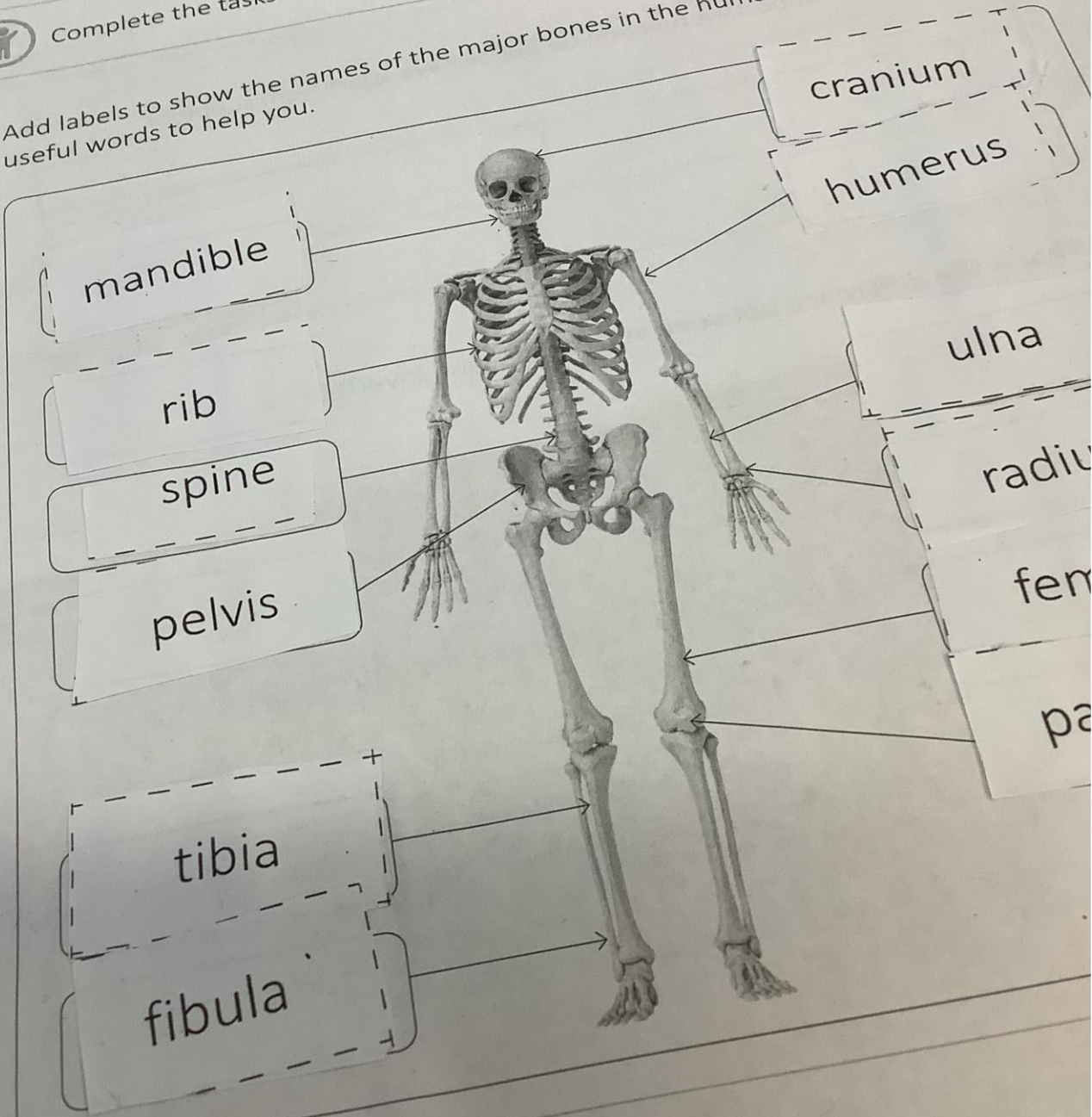
We were all interested in how nature worked and how everything is linked together through the seasons to make sure that plants and animals could grow and thrive.
